In 1980 Windellema was discovered as the location of the World's rarest Eucalypt , *Eucalyptus Recurva*; Also known as the Mongarlowe Mallee, there are only 5 plants in the world. The largest is in Windellema. They are remnants of ICE AGE vegetation;

The Windellema plant is 13,000 years old. It is the oldest living plant in the World.

There are only 5 known:- 3 in Braidwood and 2 in Windellema. They are not able to be propagated yet. BOTH of these rare stands are in the range of the plume of the Toxic waste ;permanent poisons in the soils from fallout; These are the last in the World; The predictive range is in the Bungonia, Windellema area.

Eucalyptus Recurva is also at the Highest level of protection under Government legislation.

These key creeks are in the Sydney Water Catchment; their catchment is widespread throughout the District and flowing from past Tarago through Windellema for miles and miles.

We don't want the contaminants; furans; PBC's and other Heavy metals and toxic wastes contaminating the catchment of the creeks we manage .
