Thank you for your letter informing about the exhibition process and the allowance of making a submission in relation to the proposed development of the construction and operation of the Woodlawn Advanced Energy Recovery Centre near Tarago. I have read and acknowledge and accept the Department's disclaimer and declaration. I also confirm that I have not made a political donation.

I object to the proposed development because I verily believe that such an operation would cause the release of harmful toxins into the environment which would ultimately affect the health of all residing in Tarago and surrounding areas.
