Object to the application for a waste incinerator on the grounds that it will have a detrimental impact on the health of humans, flora, fauna, air, water & soil not only on the area surrounding Tarago area but also as far as the wind will blow.

As reported in The Guardian & on CNN on 1 January 2020 with a further article published by the Wellington Post on 2 January 2020, smoke, ash & dust blown across from the Australian bushfires covered the mountains & polluted the air of New Zealand. Further to this samples collected from New Zealand glaciers have found it relatively common to find evidence of dust that has blown across from Australia typically from NSW, northwest Victoria, South Australia & occasionally Western Australia.

The attached article contains solid evidence regarding waste sites and their impact on health. The article comes from Science Direct, a scientific journal article repository. This article discusses the observed connections between waste exposure & negative health outcomes over a 7 year period. To ignore it would be ignoring solid peer reviewed scientific fact.
