After reading the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) on this project, I wish to lodge the following comments:

Careful planning must be given to construction and location of the proposed water control ponds on land to resumed and adjoining my properties. My concern is the impact that could be generated by the accidental spilling of fuel and chemicals resulting from motor accidents and contaminated rainfall runoff overflowing from the water control ponds. If this was to happen, it would have a devastating effect on both the swampland and floodplain further downstream and to the north of the proposed motorway.
