The transmission lines from the national park to the substation near Uralla are not suitable for this pastoral setting.

This project has already had 3 different owners. How can we have faith in the developers if they have already sold the project. Vestas aren't even going to be the company to build the project.

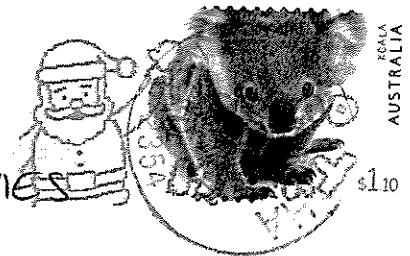
