The reason for my position stated above is the following: As a partner in a farming business in the Walcha area, I don't believe the developer has informed us enough regarding the ~~the~~ agricultural industry - the loss of access to agricultural land through construction exclusion, access roads and site areas. The impact on ability to make use of aerial services, including chemical spraying, and the spreading of seed and fertilizer. The fire risk also on agricultural land and the impact on our ability to fight fires in the gorge country with planes and helicopters with CASA indicating to avoid areas with wind turbine constructions.
