Thank you for the notification in relation to the SSD for alterations and additions to St Philip's Christian College.

Council would like to reiterate its comments previously made to the Department dated 10 March 2022 in relation to flooding and access. It is assumed that the Department will undertake a full assessment of these matters and TfNSW will also provide additional comment in relation to the suitability of the access. In terms of the proposed characterisation of the aquatic centre, Council believe that this is best characterised as a 'recreation facility (indoor)' which is currently prohibited in the zone.

In addition, I would like to bring to your attention a recent resolution of Council in relation to the intersection of Lomas Lane and Wine Country Drive. Council has resolved to support a signalised intersection at this location consistent with the amended proposal. I have attached a copy of the resolution for your information.
