My objections to SSD-21208499 Glanmire Solar Farm are:

- Location the area earmarked for this development should remain rural grazing + crop production. This area has fine soil & has been productive for many decades. Another suitable area with poorer soils & less production / farmhouses could be found. Food supply is becoming a major concern & Australia requires every hectare of productive land to be dedicated to ensuring supply can be maintained without foreign imports.
