I object to the Hills of Gold Wind Farm Amended Development Application on Public Exhibition.

I am aware how important Oakenville Street and Jenkins Street are to the surrounding residents and do not want to see the ease of living interrupted by 6 daily Oversize Overmass vehicles and Parking Restrictions during Blade deliveries for nine months.

Nundle has an elderly population who live in their homes into their nineties and still drive. Nundle and Hanging Rock are safe and quiet places for them to do that. They can easily access services.

This proposal is a threat to the amenity of local residents moving around daily in the village, or driving to Tamworth or Quirindi for shopping or medical services.

Long term the development proposes significant ecological damage to birds. I do not agree with the threat to protected birds like Nankeen Kestrel, Brown Goshawk and Wedge-Tailed Eagles from blade strike. Mitigation and curtailment are not acceptable. This is the wrong location for a wind farm so close to Ben Halls Gap Nature Reserve and Crawney Pass National Park.
