I submit my Objection to Hills of Gold Wind Farm, adding to my previous Objection.

My home is on the proposed Crawney Road Transport Route. I am concerned that the use of Crawney Rd by Oversize and Overmass vehicles and quarry trucks will do major damage to my home because it is located on an iron stone ridge. Previously when Council paved with its road rutter it vibrated my home, rattling windows and cupboard contents.

I object to the proposed removal of street trees for both the Nundle Bypass and Nundle Loop Transport Routes. Street trees have been planted over many years to beautify the village by local residents past and present who had and have pride in their village.

Further, the restricted parking proposed in Jenkins and Oakenville Streets is not acceptable. Parking is now a problem with existing parking restrictions and demand for parking in the village, particularly impacting an ageing population who cannot walk to access essential services. Wind Farm associated parking restrictions will only add to their problems and limit their independence.

Continuing division within the community is evident and does not bode well for cohesive administration or participation in a Community Enhancement Fund.

I do not accept the indirect impacts to biodiversity in Ben Halls Gap Nature Reserve or Crawney Pass National Park, or direct impacts from clearing in the Project Area and roadsides.

The reason why the majority of people live in and come to Nundle is we love the landscape, and peace. The Visual, and Traffic and Transport Impacts of the Hills of Gold Wind Farm would reduce the enjoyment of people's homes and recreation areas.
