My objections are:

- 1. Delay to services to Nundle and its residents by the closure of our main and only road.
- My personal situation is that I have a life threatening disease which has necessitude the need for an ambulance in an emergency situation. At the present time there are already delays in timely arrival of medical help, as we do not have a resident doctor in Nundle.
- 3. Further such delays may occur if this project is approved, causing further anxiety.
- 4. I object strongly to the proposed transport of oversized components and the traffic volumes through the village, as well as the proposed modifications of the intersections and bridges. Our roads are collapsing under wet weather conditions and logging trucks. The bridge on Old Hanging Rock Road recently got damaged and it is located on the proposed blade transport route.
- 5. As a long-term resident and ex gold miner, I am aware of many old mines running underneath the whole of Hanging Rock road system. The instability of the tunnels under the roads can cause a collapse at any time. This possibility has not been addressed by the proponent.
- This wind farm proposal will alter forever the fabric of our town, whose economy is based mainly on farming and tourism.
- 7. Why introduce a project which will vitally affect our normal daily life in so many ways.
- I understand the need for alternative energy sources, but this town is unique, in that has seriously limited access.
- 9. Nundle is a life-style destination. This is the place where people drive to, not drive through.
