Description of the development consent

Upgrades to Hastings Secondary College Port Macquarie Campus, including refurbishment of parts of two existing buildings, provision of a two storey Creative and Performing Arts (CAPA) building, joint use PCYC facility, covered outdoor learning area (COLA), new covered walkways and lift connections, and upgrades to the school entrance and signage. Associated works include demolition, tree removal, earthworks, landscaping, stormwater works and services upgrades.

Description of proposed modification

The modification application seeks approval for design changes to the PCYC Building component of the development, including but not limited to:

- new rear extension
- deletion of the basement carpark
- new at-grade parking at the rear
- roof configuration changes including installation of roof top ventilators
- relocation of the pedestrian entry
- building facade including materials and treatments
- landscape design, including additional tree planting.

About the exhibition

An exhibition process allows any individual or organisation to have their say about a proposed development.

The Department of Planning and Environment (the department) has received an application to modify the abovementioned approved State significant development (SSD).
