Description of the development consent

The Maules Creek Coal Mine is an existing open cut coal mine in the Gunnedah Coalfield, approved to extract coal at a rate of up to 13 million tonnes per annum (Mtpa) of run-of-mine (ROM) coal until 31 December 2034.

Description of proposed modification

Construction and use of a 700-metre powerline between the Roma Bore pump and existing 11kV powerline, and changes to the existing biodiversity offset strategy for the mine.

About the exhibition

An exhibition process allows any individual or organisation to have their say about a proposed development.

The Department of Planning and Environment (the department) has received an application to modify the abovementioned approved State significant development (SSD). The application and accompanying documents (including the modification report) are on exhibition from **Friday 02 December 2022** until **Thursday 15 December 2022**.
