Description of the development consent

Adaptive reuse of the Lands and Education buildings for hotel accommodation and ancillary uses, including the demolition, excavation and construction of a subterranean tunnel link below Loftus Street and roof extensions above each building.

The modification application seeks approval for the demolition and replacement of ceilings and cornices on the lower ground, ground and level one of the Lands Building.
