My business relies heavily on road transport to the south - Goulburn via Paling Yards - and through Oberon to Bathurst and beyond. Disruption to deliveries and stock movements would be a major impediment to our everyday management. In reality, the heavy truck movements along Abercrombie Road would also be a threat to our safety. My wife travels along those roads for work and can ill-afford hold-ups. Once again, safety risks are a concern.

I believe that wind farms are not efficient providers of energy. Thos who work to maintain them say that every time the wind dies down and the rotors become still, massive drains on the grid are required for start-up. This is ridiculously inefficient.

I also believe that, contrary to prolific propaganda, these ugly monsters are NOT good for the environment. The talk about recycling of the massive amounts of concrete, steel and components is over-simplified. No one speaks of the resources - both fiscal, in relation to energy consumption, and the very complexity of the process - involved in recycling of the towers. Proponents also fail to mention that the blades are not recyclable. A bit of an oversight!
