Description of proposal

Construction of a new wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) including a recycled water plant, associated pipelines and infrastructure to service Thrumster, Sancrox and Fernbank Creek, with catchment diversions pipes from the Port Macquarie Wastewater Scheme. Key elements of the proposal include:

- New WWTP and recycled water plant on land at 433 Fernbank Creek Road, approximately six kilometres west of Port Macquarie CBD
- Treated effluent pipeline to Kooloonbung Creek
- Main access road and a flood-proof, all weather access road to the WWTP
- New sewer pump stations, sewer rising mains, recycled water mains and a potable water connection
- Upgrade works at identified existing sewer pump stations (SPSs) to reduce the load on the existing system.
- Provision of utilities such as optic fibre connection and electricity supply.

About the exhibition

An exhibition process allows any individual or organisation to have their say about a proposed development.

The Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure (the department) has received a State significant infrastructure (SSI) application for the abovementioned proposal. The application, environmental impact statement (EIS) and accompanying documents are on exhibition from **Tue 06 August 2024** until **Mon 02 September 2024**. At the time of publishing this advertisement, the Minister for Planning and Public Spaces has not directed that a public hearing should be held.
