I moved to Catherine Field to be away from intrusive buildings and excessive noise and traffic. The idea of eleven years of construction virtually in our front yard and increased traffic in our surrounding streets is absurd.

I have included pictures of a property directly across from the proposed exit driveway which is and will remain to be affected by overland flow in large rain events, of which we have experienced multiple over the last few years.

From reviewing the documents, the overland flows will not be carried into planned storage tanks but directed off site and impacting others.

Minarah College claim they are considering the impacts of local residents but they are only concerned about pushing flood waters away from their site. There is no report or diagram that shows they have listened to the Planning Department to "The RtS must confirm that the proposed stormwater drainage regime would not adversely impact on any downstream properties, nearby watercourses or riparian land. Mitigation measures should be proposed where

I have attached photos of the overland flow as I don't believe the severity has been taken into account with this proposal.



Proposed stormwater drainage will heavily impact residents of 277 <u>Catherine Field road</u> and 285 Catherine Field and those further downstream



The stormwater drainage does nothing to mitigate flooding downstream of the site

The plans show a concrete median right in front of the driveway of 265 Catherine Field. This will restrict the residents from turning right out of their driveway at any time fording them to left turn only. This is a major concern as it is unsafe to expect the residents to turn left out of their driveway because it is unsafe to perform a u-turn any where along Catherine Field road. The resident will also be unable to turn right into their driveway if they are coming from Deepfield road direction.
