RE: Life Sciences Precinct

Representatives from my office met with the Kurraba Group in June about their proposal for a Life Sciences precinct on Botany Road, Waterloo, which is in my electorate.

I am writing to support this proposal as it represents an important collaboration with all levels of government to create the first commercialised Life Sciences campus in Australia.

It is expected to generate 1,200 jobs during construction and over 1,700 full-time jobs once operational, providing a significant boost to our local economy and offering valuable employment opportunities.

One of the most compelling aspects of the project is its commitment to life-saving healthcare, particularly through the establishment of NSW's first Proton Cancer Therapy treatment centre.
