Description of proposal

Redevelopment of the Malek Fahd Islamic School comprising:

- demolition of existing primary school buildings
- site preparation and earth works
- construction of a new 2 storey primary school building including:
 - learning rooms and informal learning areas
 - Out of Hours School Care (OSHC) room
 - covered outdoor learning area (COLA)
 - staff administration rooms
 - multi-purpose hall
 - early learning centre
- construction of a new 2 storey secondary girls school building
- construction of a new 2 storey secondary boys school building
- reconfiguration of an existing secondary school building
- construction of a new 3 storey prayer hall
- construction of a new 2 storey administration and canteen building
- construction of a new 2 storey library
- construction of a single-storey secondary school multi-purpose hall
- outdoor sports/soccer field
- new internal service road along the north boundary with new entry/exit on Mungerie Road
- new vehicle access point on Mungerie Road to a 147 space basement carpark for staff, drop-off/pick-up and loading/unloading
- reconfiguration of existing at grade vehicle parking with 40 spaces
- associated landscaping, tree removal and infrastructure works.

The Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure (the department) has received a State significant development (SSD) application for the abovementioned proposal.
