Orange Grove Solar Farm (SSD 8882)

Orange Grove Sun Farm Pty Ltd (OGSF) advises that it is our intention to shortly lodge our Response to Submissions (RtS) for the Orange Grove Solar Farm EIS. OGSF provides notification to DPE that the RtS will include a design change whereby the development footprint is amended having further considered and assessed the potential impacts of the project in response to the submissions received.

OGSF advises the development footprint amendment is within the bounds of the EIS development site boundary and is designed to directly address issues raised in the various submissions, in particular:

- Potential flood impact – OGSF proposes to exclude a first order stream within the current development footprint;
- Public concern for biodiversity impacts – OGSF proposes a reduction in the number of established trees requiring felling; and
- Proximity to receptors R1, R2 & the gun club – OGSF proposes boundary setbacks & further distances away from infrastructure.

Figure 1 attached provides the proposed changes to the development footprint prior to the formal submission of the RtS.
