**This is a submission to the Hume Coal Project EIS. SSD7172**

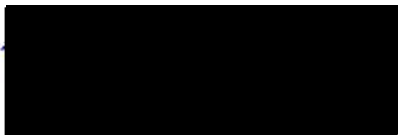
I object to this project and recommend that it be rejected.

I have lived in Berrima for over 40 years. My parents originally brought 40 acres of uncleared land in Berrima in the early 1970's, which we have always run as a horse stud and primary industry. I have raised both my children on the property and also own a shop in the village. I also worked for 20 years as a registered nurse at the local hospital. Living and working in this area has helped develop a strong connection to Berrima for myself and my family. The mine will considerably negatively impact our lives and my concerns are: -

Water - Clean bore water is essential as it provides water to our stock and house during times of drought. The mine places threat risk.  
Air quality - The stockpile is likely to significantly affect air quality. We are so concerned about this we are considering selling and moving. This is causing significant stress in our family.  
This project must be rejected.
