Description of proposal

Concept development application for a shop-top housing development with in-fill affordable housing, comprising a building envelope with a maximum height of 13 storeys (RL 78.12) and a maximum gross floor area of 5,529.8sqm for residential and retail uses.

No physical works are proposed as part of this concept proposal. Future physical works will be subject to separate development applications.

About the exhibition

The Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure (the department) has received a State significant development (SSD) application for the abovementioned proposal.
