My home in Crooble is approx. 50 metres from the present railway line and I understand there are no plans to change that, which is fine. Your reference for our home is NNS\_Rx2287 and the decibel reading is 65dba (5dba above recommended). I would like to know how this issue is to be resolved. Also the house is 75 years old and sits on old timber stumps. I am worried about the vibration that will be caused by the trains and the resultant impact on the house foundations and other parts of the house construction. There is a railway crossing approx 300 metres from the house on the southern side and another railway crossing approx 100 metres from the house on the northern side. A further crossing is approximately 1klm further north of the house again. The regular horn blowing by the trains as they approach these crossings will be of significant annoyance and I would like to have this issue addressed. Thank you
