**Your Comments\*:**

My concerns are regarding:-

1) The loss of the community facilities is the netball courts etc at Cheltenham Oval. I was told at a community meeting that they would be lost for several years. These facilities are used during the week for sports days / carnivals by many local schools and <sup>these facilities are used every weekend,</sup> there are no suitable ovals / facilities nearby.

The Scout Hall off Kirkham St would pose an ideal position for the proposed egress etc as the Scout Hall is used only one night per week and by a small number of Scouts. These scouts could be relocated to a nearby (500mtrs) facility already used by older scouts.

2) The location of the egress is sopposed to be approximately half way between stations. This is not the case in Castle Howard Rd, Cheltenham. Again Kirkham St Scout Hall would be a little closer to the halfway mark or possibly a position <sup>2</sup> closer to the M2 intersection with Remnant Hills Rd. In the event of an emergency —

emergency vehicles would then have  
immediate access to the M2 and both  
Royal North Shore and Westmead Hospitals.  
The Scout Hall area off Kirkham St  
would also have less of an impact  
on homes in Castle Howard Rd.

Also if there was to be an emergency  
~~exit~~ the proposed egress in Castle  
Howard Rd could not be accessed  
efficiently by emergency vehicles as the road  
is a no through road and it is very  
narrow - only one lane for most of it.
