

Objection to Proposed Monaro Rock Quarry

To: NSW Major Projects.

I am writing to express my strong objection to the proposed rock quarry in Royalla NSW.

My home is close to the site, and I am extremely worried about the impacts this development will have on both my health and our community.

I live with asthma, which means that dust and fine particles are not just an inconvenience — they are a serious health hazard. Even small amounts of quarry dust in the air could trigger asthma attacks and put me at risk of lasting damage to my lungs. Living near to such an operation would mean I am constantly exposed, which is not something anyone should have to face in their own home.

Beyond my personal health, I believe this quarry will negatively affect the whole community. Increased dust, noise, and heavy truck traffic will reduce the quality of life for everyone nearby.

Our homes should be places of safety and clean air, not areas put at risk by industrial activity on our doorstep.

I urge you to consider the health and wellbeing of residents like myself when making your decision. This quarry may bring short-term economic gain, but the long-term cost to community health, safety, and lifestyle is far too great.

Please do not allow this proposal to go ahead so close to where people live.
