COBBORA SOLAR FARM ABORIGINAL CULTURAL HERITAGE ASSESSMENT REPORT RESPONSE TO SUBMISSIONS

Dear Corey,

This response has been prepared by OzArk Environment & Heritage (OzArk) on behalf of Pacific Partnerships Pty Ltd (the proponent) to respond to the detailed Aboriginal Cultural Heritage advice provided by Heritage NSW regarding the *Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment Report* (ACHAR) for the Cobbora Solar Farm project (the project). The advice was received on 9 October 2025.

- The SEARS require the ACHAR to identify and assess impacts on Aboriginal cultural heritage within the site and adjoining haulage routes, including those from earthworks, construction, and road works. The EIS states that "additional Aboriginal cultural heritage surveys are proposed at each of the proposed Access Points" (p.117). Heritage NSW requests confirmation of the timing for these surveys and clarification on whether the ACHAR addresses potential impacts from adjoining haulage routes as required by the SEARs. The ACHAR must also be updated to include detailed information on the nature and location of transport and access works. Where possible, Heritage NSW's preference is for all archaeological assessment (i.e., survey and test excavations) to be conducted prior to any project approval to ensure that the RAPs, Heritage NSW, and the Department are informed of any potential impacts and conservation measures for Aboriginal cultural heritage within the project area.***

An additional survey was undertaken to address the proposed construction of additional internal haulage access routes, road upgrades along Sandy Creek Road, upgrades to four additional site access points, and widening of two discrete areas along Spring Ridge Road. The addendum study area describes the area in which all impacts associated with the proposed additional works will occur. In terms of additional survey of the addendum study area, only those areas not surveyed for OzArk 2025 were subject of additional survey.

The result of the additional survey is reported within the Addendum ACHAR (OzArk 2026). A summary of the results and recommendations following the additional survey are presented below.

The additional survey was undertaken on Thursday 12 February by OzArk Project Archaeologist, Imogen Crome, with the assistance of Murray Clynes representing Wellington Valley Wiradjuri Aboriginal Corporation.

The survey of the access roads resulted in the recording of one previously unrecorded isolated artefact, 36-2-0866 (SCR-IF1), which was identified in a secondary context along Sandy Creek Road.

The artefact scatters associated with 36-2-0207 (SAC 04), 36-2-0208 (SAC 05), 36-2-0211 (SAC 08), and 36-2-0416 (CBR-OS-01) were found to extend onto Sandy Creek Road within the disturbance area for the proposed haulage route upgrades. The PADs associated with these sites were found to have been subject to further deterioration through ongoing erosional processes and road maintenance activities and their extents have been updated to only include undisturbed landforms. The PAD extents associated with these sites will not be harmed by the proposed works.

Three scarred trees registered on AHIMS were visited (36-2-0256 [TRE 07], 36-2-0257 ([TRE 08], and 36-2-0258 [TRE 09]). However, only 36-2-0256 (TRE 07) was able to be positively identified. It is likely that both 36-2-0257 (TRE 08) and 36-2-0258 (TRE 09) have fallen/burnt and / or been removed since their original recording. As such, these sites are no longer valid and an Aboriginal Site Impact Recording Form (ASIRF) will be submitted to AHIMS accordingly.

The following recommendations are made in addition to the recommendations contained in the ACHAR (OzArk 2025):

1. 36-2-0866 (SCR-IF1) and the portions of 36-2-0207 (SAC 04), 36-2-0208 (SAC 05), 36-2-0211 (SAC 08), and 36-2-0416 (CBR-OS-01) that are located within the addendum study area, should be salvaged via surface collection in accordance with an approved ACHMP following project approval.
 - a. The recommended methodology for the salvage will include the measures outlined in Section 9.2.1 of the Addendum ACHAR.
 - b. The salvage works will include the mapping, analysis, and collection of the surface artefact at the affected site. Results will be included in a brief report to preserve the data in a useable form and an ASIRF will be submitted to AHIMS.
2. The management measures outlined in Section 9.2.2 of the Addendum ACHAR will be followed for 36-2-0256 (TRE 07).
3. The portions of 36-2-0207 (SAC 04), 36-2-0208 (SAC 05), 36-2-0211 (SAC 08), and 36-2-0416 (CBR-OS-01) that will not be harmed by the works, must be fenced following the procedure set out in Section 9.2.4 of the Addendum ACHAR.
2. ***The ACHAR notes “generous site and PAD extents” (p. 57) and expresses confidence that sites and PADs do not extend into the Development Footprint (p.xi). However, the validity of this confidence is unclear given the low visibility reported during the survey and the absence of the test excavations typically used to increase visibility and confirm boundaries. Please update the ACHAR to explain how site and PAD boundaries were determined in accordance with Requirements 6 and 7 of the Code of Practice for Archaeological Investigation of Aboriginal Objects in NSW (the Code of Practice; DECCW 2010), including discussion of the potential for artefacts to occur beyond visible areas. Where adequate explanation cannot be provided, a test excavation program will be required as per the SEARs. We note that as per Requirement 15(b) of the Code of Practice, and to avoid undue harm through unnecessary excavations of the areas of PADs/sites not proposed for disturbance, the sampling strategy in this instance may be***

developed to include testing to confirm areas of low potential and/or include areas of null testing within the Development Footprint (i.e., verify the sites/PADs do not extend into areas proposed for impact).

The assessment of PADs within the Project Area considered multiple factors including landform type, disturbance levels, A-Horizon soil integrity, distance to water, and ground surface visibility.

Regarding the PADs recorded or extended by OzArk during the 2022 surveys, these were determined through the in-person assessment of the integrity of the elevated landforms adjacent to creeks and their distance to water. The following examples provide a sample of the justification of PAD extents adjacent to Laheys and Sandy Creeks:

- PAD 20 (**Figure 1**) encompasses an elevated rise above the junction of Laheys and Sandy Creeks and extends both east and south adjacent to each creek line. The PAD excludes the creek flats associated with the creeks as these are poor preservers of archaeological deposits due to flooding and channel migration. The southern and eastern boundaries of the PAD are defined by the increased distance to the creeks in conjunction with the rise in elevation toward the south-eastern ridgeline. The slopes of the ridgeline are degrading and exhibited thin soils.
- The extent of PAD 30 (**Figure 2**) comprises a gently elevated knoll above the southern bank of Laheys Creek. The PAD is set back from the flat, undifferentiated landform which is immediately adjacent to the creek bank. The knoll would have provided a preferential location for camping due to its elevated position in proximity to the creek.

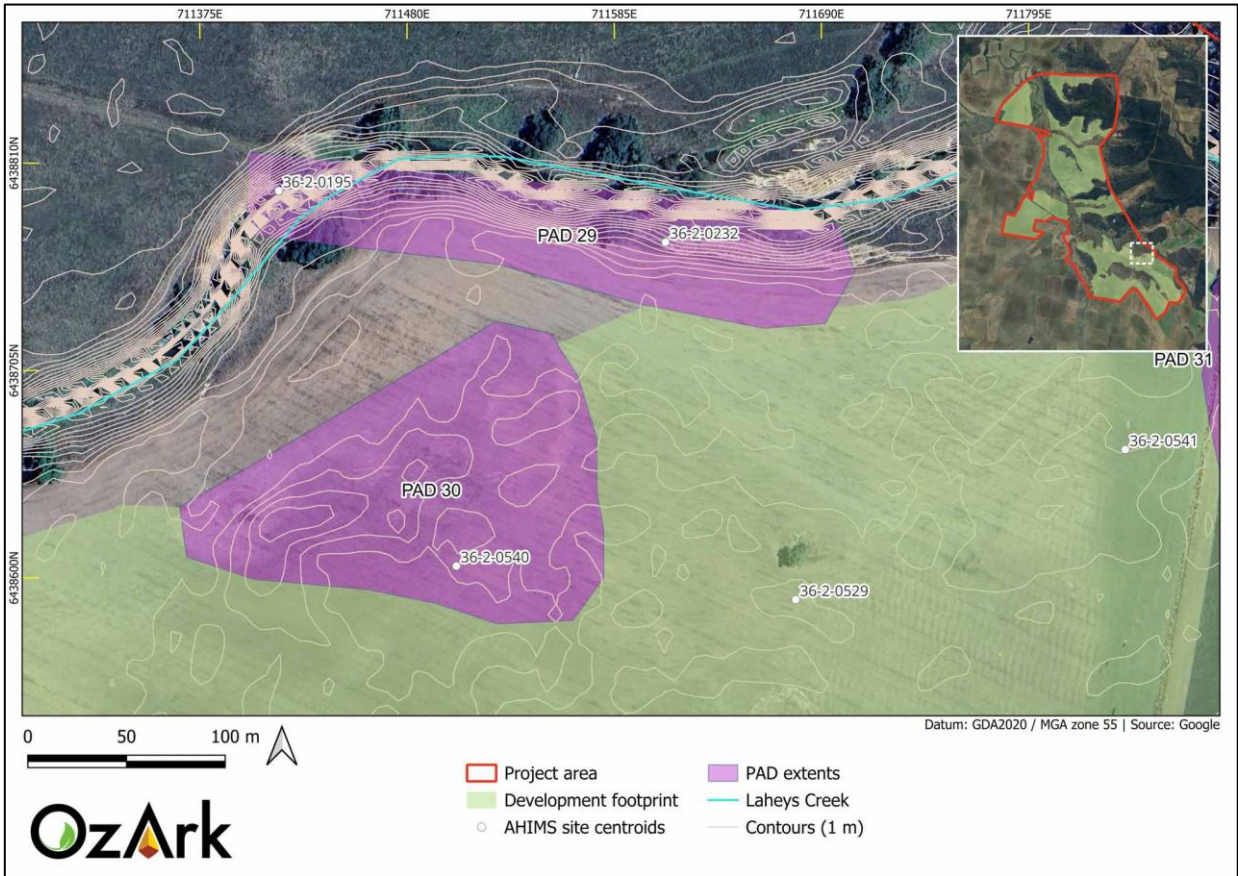


Figure 3: Detailed view of landform associated with PAD 8.

- PAD 8 (**Figure 3**) is located along Sandy Creek at its junction with an ephemeral tributary. The western boundary of the stream channels presents a defined rise, on which multiple previously recorded sites have been identified (36-2-0185, 36-2-0221, 36-2-0182, 36-2-0183, 36-2-0184). This rise, associated with such a substantial waterway, would have been an attractive location for occupation by Aboriginal peoples. The PAD was extended east to incorporate site 36-2-0220 on the southern bank of Sandy Creek, as well as the transitional landform in which 36-2-0524 was recorded. However, further east beyond the PAD boundary, the landform is a very gently undulating plain with no defining features characteristic of increased archaeological potential.

Figure 1 to **Figure 3** provide views over these PAD areas with 1 metre (m) contour lines to demonstrate the subtle landform changes visible during the pedestrian assessment which lead to the determination of PAD boundaries.

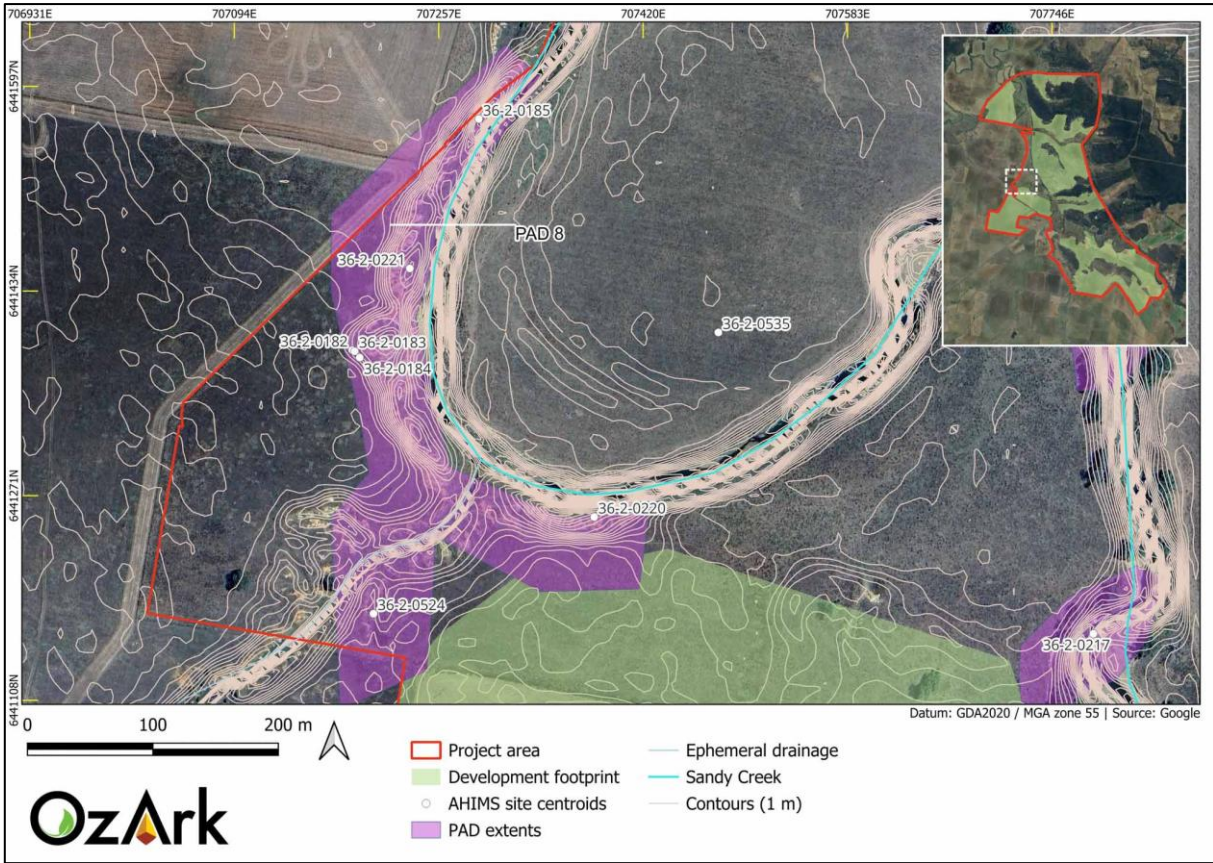
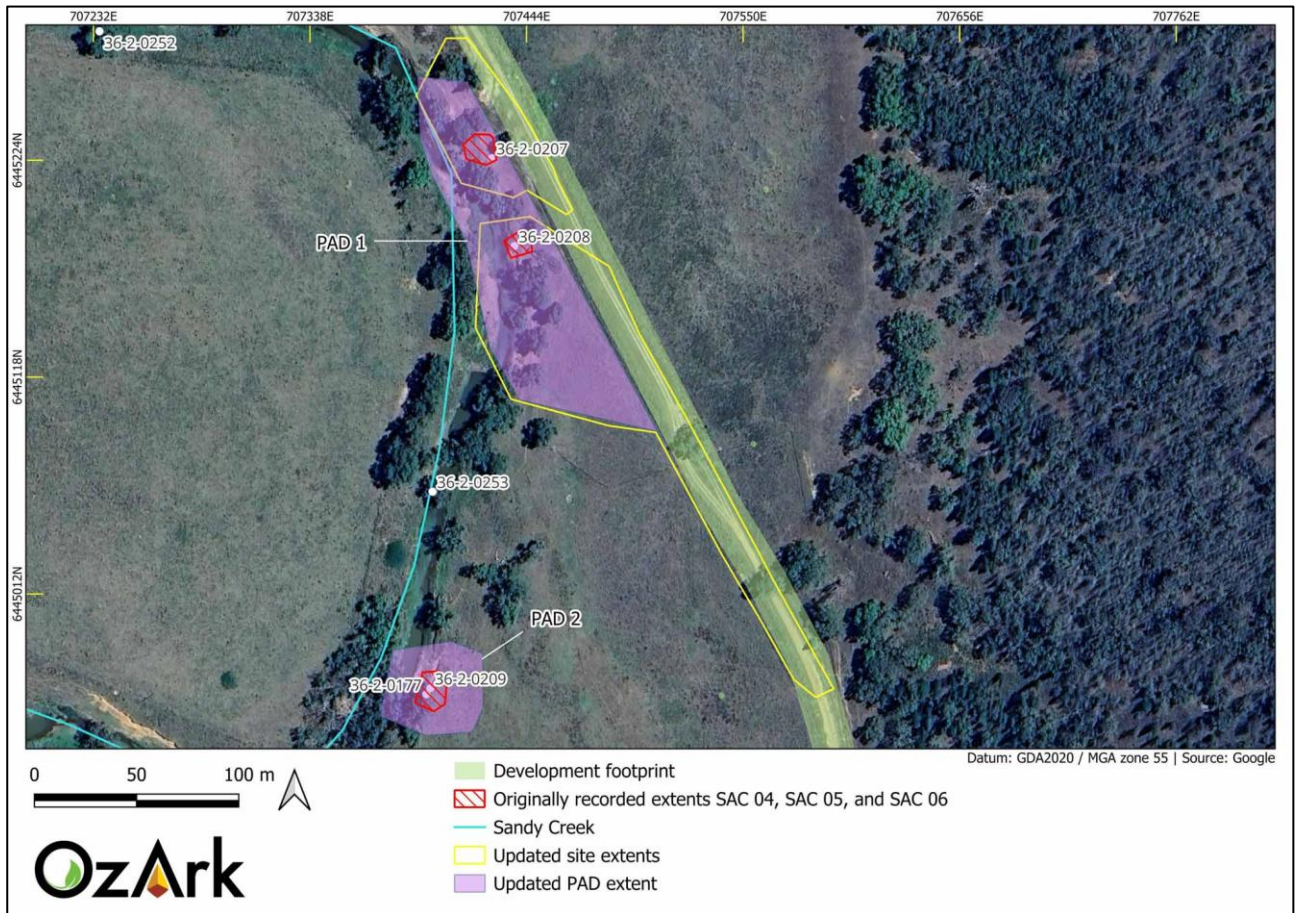


Figure 4: View of buffered PAD extents in relation to originally recorded extents.

The reference to “generous PAD extents” within the ACHAR refers to the fact that large buffers were applied to the PADs as a precautionary measure to ensure that all areas of potential sensitivity were enveloped within the PAD extents presented in the ACHAR. For example, where PADs had been recorded as part of previous studies (ERM 2010, EMM 2012, and EMM 2013) and were found to still be intact or partially intact, a wider boundary was applied. For example, the areas of PAD associated with sites 36-2-0207 (SAC 04), 36-2-0208 (SAC 05), and SAC 06 (36-2-0209) were initially recorded to be discrete areas along the eastern bank of Sandy Creek. However, a precautionary buffer was applied around these areas to include the surrounding landforms (**Figure 4**). This can also be seen in PAD 29 as shown on **Figure 2**, north of PAD 30.

3. ***Further analysis is required regarding the Aboriginal flaked glass artefact site (AHIMS 36-2-0192) with the Development Footprint. Such sites are indicative of contact-period archaeology, which is generally rare, yet this does not appear to have been considered in the ACHAR's significance assessment, which states: "There are no known historical Aboriginal values associated with the Project area" (p.134). The update must address the potential for additional flakes glass artefacts that may contribute to the site's research potential and cultural value. Where further contact archaeology may be present, additional investigation and management will be required.***

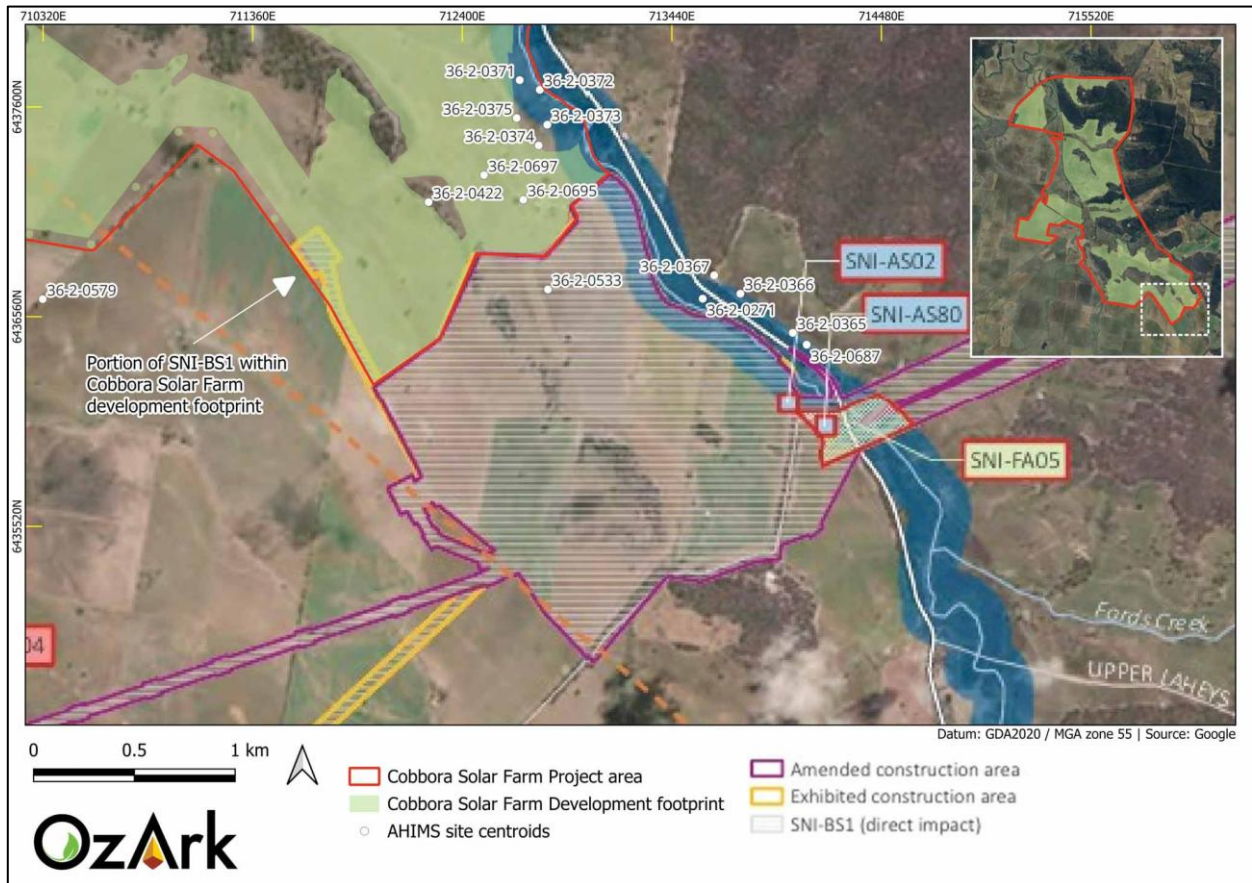
Figure 5: 36-2-0192 (IF 01-Glass flake). View of site and selection of site features.

The initial site card for 36-2-0192 was submitted in 2009 by ERM Consulting who recorded an isolated glass flake exhibiting retouch and a point of impact (**Figure 5**). The artefact was recorded on a farm track adjacent to Sandy Creek. During the field assessment for the ACHAR in 2022, the site was revisited, and while the glass flake could not be located, two further artefacts were recorded in the vicinity: a quartz core and a quartz flake.

During the additional survey undertaken for the Addendum ACHAR, an additional visit to 36-2-0192 was completed. Efforts were made to relocate the glass flake recorded in 2009, and to identify any indications of interpretable contact archaeology which could contribute to the assessment of historic values in the project area.

Despite all efforts to locate the glass flake, the artefact could not be identified. This is largely attributed to the ongoing agricultural use of the landform.

Approximately 90 m south of the recorded location for the glass flake, an Aboriginal stone anvil was recorded (**Figure 5**). The anvil is located on the western edge of the paddock and is approximately 17 m east of Sandy Creek, located within the extended site extent shown in the ACHAR.

The recording of one isolated glass flake within a disturbed agricultural context does not provide sufficient information to assign historic value to the site. The glass fragment that comprises the flake is from a bottle wall, and while there is evidence of embossed lettering, there are no diagnostic features which lend to an accurate inference of date. Beyond an understanding that the artefact must have been manufactured in a post-contact period, the artefact has limited ability to further inform researchers on Aboriginal use of the area in the post-contact period.

As Heritage NSW noted in their submission, glass flakes are generally rare within the region. However, as the site was recorded within a secondary context, has not been locatable during the past two site visits (likely having been further displaced in the last 17 years), and is not associated with other post-contact items, OzArk maintains that the 36-2-0192 has little or no historic significance.

4. ***As noted in the ACHAR, several Aboriginal sites within the Development Footprint were originally recorded in association with other projects intersecting the Project Area, such as Central West Orana Renewable Energy Zone (CWO REZ) transmission line.***
 - a. ***Please confirm whether the proposed management measures (e.g., surface salvage of Aboriginal objects) align with existing commitments for these sites under current approvals***

While the surveyed area for the CWO REZ intersected with the southern portion of the Project Area for the proposed Cobbora Solar Farm, the final footprint for CWO REZ was reduced to exclude the entirety of the Project Area to accommodate for the Elong Elong Hub. As such, 36-2-0679 (SNI-AS47) and 36-2-0695 (SNI-AS48), registered within the Project Area as part of the CWO REZ surveys, are not considered within the CWO REZ *Heritage Management Plan* (the CWO REZ HMP; Acciona 2025). Site 36-3-4122 (SNI-BS1) overlaps with the Project Area (see Point 5 below). This site was recorded by EMM as a very low density background artefact scatter predicted to occur across the entire landscape and was assessed to have low cultural and archaeological significance. The site is considered within the CWO REZ HMP, however, as it is a general background scatter which is predicted to occur across the CWO construction area and is not registered based on the actual identification of objects, no mitigation measures are required to be undertaken prior to construction under the CWO REZ HMP.

It is proposed that the site 36-3-4122 (SNI-BS1) be subject to the same management measures for the proposed Cobbora Solar Farm project, in which no targeted salvage should be undertaken prior to construction at this site. Rather, should Aboriginal objects be identified within this site during the proposed works, they will be subject to an Unanticipated Finds Protocol. This has been included within the revised recommendations (**Figure 6**).

- b. Please confirm whether additional actions are required for sites subject to overlapping approvals, such as notifying existing approval holders of proposed salvage or changes in site status following salvage.**

While the initially exhibited construction area for the CWO REZ overlapped with the southern-most portion of the current Project Area, the revised CWO REZ construction area was reduced to meet at the southern border of the Project Area. While the registered extent of site 36-3-4122 (SNI-BS1) intersects with the Project Area, as there are no mitigation measures required for impact to the site under the CWO REZ ACHMP, notification to existing approval holders is not necessary.

- 5. Heritage NSW notes that, as part of the CWO REZ project, EMM registered a large background scatter 'site' (SNI-BS1; AHIMS 36-3-4122) on the Aboriginal Heritage Information Management System (AHIMS), covering the entire CWO construction area. Please clarify whether the current Project Area and / or Development footprint intersects with the CWO construction area and, consequently, with SNI-BS1 (AHIMS 36-3-4122). If there is any overlap, the current ACHAR must be updated to acknowledge this registration.**

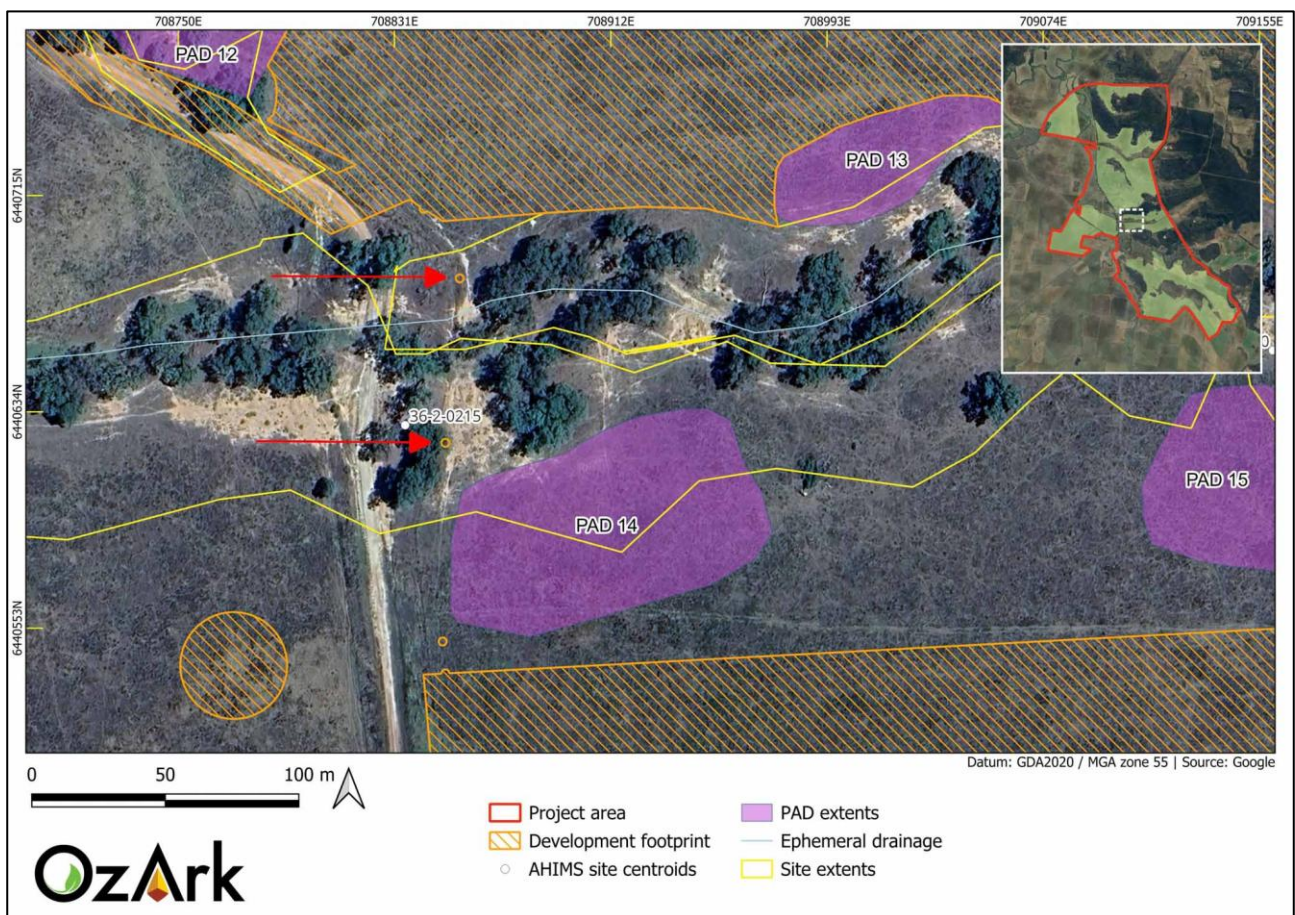
As discussed above in Point 4 (a), a small area in the southernmost portion of the Project Area and disturbance footprint overlap with 36-3-4122 (SNI-BS1). As such, partial impact to this site is proposed by the project. Although no mitigation measures are required to impact this site, and no Aboriginal objects were identified within the Project Area, a recommendation has been added noting that the Project will partially impact this 'background scatter' site.

- 6. SAC 12 (AHIMS 36-2-0215) and SAC 13 (AHIMS 36-2-0216) comprise artefact scatters**

with PAD and are proposed to be impacted by the project. The ACHAR recommends only mapping, description, and collection of surface artefact within the Development Footprint prior to construction. Please clarify why no additional management measures, such as salvage excavation, are proposed to address potential harm to sub-surface components of these sites.

The proposed impacts within the site extent for 36-2-0215 (SAC 12) and 36-2-0216 (SAC 13) are limited to the installation of electricity poles for the proposed 33kV easement. While these impacts are located within the site extent for the surface artefact scatters recorded, they are located outside the recorded areas of PAD associated with the sites. Further, the proposed electricity poles are located in areas subject to soil loss through erosion (**Figure 7**). As such, the mitigation measures recommended for the impacts to these sites consists of surface salvage only and no test excavation is considered necessary.

- 7. Heritage NSW recommends that untested PADs be registered on AHIMS to ensure appropriate investigation, assessment, and management if future works are proposed nearby. Please confirm whether all untested PADs have been registered on AHIMS, either individually or in association with recorded surface sites.**

All PADs have been registered on the AHIMS database with the exception of PADs 6, 12, 15, 17, 26, 30, and 32. OzArk will ensure these PADs be registered on the AHIMS database as soon as practicable.

8. ***Heritage NSW notes that the AHIMS search is greater than 12 months old. As per Requirement 1b of the Code of Practice, AHIMS searches must be contemporaneous with the project (less than 12 months). Please update the AHIMS search and review for currency.***

An updated AHIMS search was undertaken on 6 February 2026. No additional sites to those considered in the ACHAR have been recorded within the search area since the last search undertaken on 5 September 2024. The 2026 AHIMS search is included in **Appendix 1**.

9. ***Mapping should be presented at a scale that clearly illustrates each Aboriginal site's relationship to other sites, key features, the Development Footprint, and the Project boundary. Several figures in the ACHAR, however, are unclear or at a scale that limits review. Specifically, we request that Figure 8-2 and Figures 9-1 to 9-3 be updated to include Aboriginal site and PAD IDs, noting that it may be necessary to provide additional figures in the ACHAR and provide Heritage NSW with required GIS files to adequately convey this information.***

OzArk has revised these figures and they are provided in **Appendix 2**.

10. ***To support Heritage NSW's assessment of the adequacy and completeness of the Aboriginal community consultation process undertaken for the project, additional documentation is required. Specifically, the consultation records must demonstrate that all RAPs were contacted at each stage of the process, in accordance with the Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Consultation Requirements for Proponents 2010 (ACHCRs; DECCW 2010). The material provided in Appendix 1, however, is incomplete and includes only sample correspondence and responses from RAPs for Stages 2/3 and 4. To address this, please provide the following:***

- a. ***Copies of Stage 1 agency notifications and all responses received.***
- b. ***Evidence that the Stage 1 registration of interest letter was sent to all identified potential Aboriginal cultural heritage knowledge holders, along with copies of all responses***
- c. ***Evidence that Stage 2/3 project information and assessment methodology notification/s were provided to all RAPs.***
- d. ***Evidence that the Stage 4 draft ACHAR was distributed to all RAPs.***

Acceptable evidence may include dated email records showing all relevant email addresses. These documents may be submitted separately for Heritage NSW's review and records.

OzArk has compiled a consultation package for the consideration of Heritage NSW to be provided alongside this Response to Submissions document. This consultation package includes, as requested, all correspondence with agencies and potential Aboriginal stakeholders during Stage 1 of the ACHCRs, as well as evidence of the publication of the Expression of Interest advertisement in the *Daily Liberal*. Also included is the distribution of the assessment methodology per Stage 2/3, and email distribution of the draft ACHAR per Stage 4, as well as all RAP responses received.

11. ***The consultation log indicates that the Stage 1 agency response from Dubbo Regional Council, received on 13 August 2024, included contact details for several potential Aboriginal stakeholders. Please clarify whether these individuals/organisations were contacted as part of the Stage 1 consultation process.***

OzArk confirms that the five potential Aboriginal stakeholders nominated by Dubbo Regional Council were contacted as part of the Stage 1 consultation process. Evidence of this contact is included within the consultation package provided to Heritage NSW.

REVISED RECOMMENDATIONS

Following considerations of the EIS advice provided by Heritage NSW and the undertaking of the Addendum ACHAR, the recommendations for concerning the Aboriginal cultural values within the Project area have been revised as follows:

1. Following the granting of development consent for the Project, the Proponent will develop an Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Management Plan (ACHMP) as per the Conditions of Approval, in consultation with the Registered Aboriginal Parties (RAPs) and NSW Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure (DPHI) (with input from Heritage NSW). The ACHMP would include an unanticipated finds protocol, unanticipated skeletal remains protocol, and heritage inductions and long-term management of any Aboriginal sites being impacted. The ACHMP must be approved by the DPHI prior to salvage and construction activities occurring.
2. Twenty-eight Aboriginal sites and three PADs are within or partially within the development footprint for the Project and will likely be harmed by the Project. The management measures outlined in Section 9.2.1 of the ACHAR (OzArk 2025) and Addendum ACHAR (OzArk 2026) should be followed for stone artefact sites and the management measures in Section 9.2.2 of the ACHAR (OzArk 2025) should be followed for PADs 11, 19, and 20.
3. The management measures outlined in Section 9.2.2 of the Addendum ACHAR (OzArk 2026) will be followed for 36-2-0256 (TRE 07).
4. Site 36-3-4122 (SNI-BS1), a large 'background scatter' site, partially extends into the Project Area. As there are no Aboriginal objects associated with this site in the Project Area, no mitigation measures within the site extent for 36-3-4122 (SNI-BS1) are required to be undertaken prior to construction.
5. Results of any salvage work will be included in a report (within 12 months of the salvage program) to preserve the data in a usable form and an Aboriginal Site Impact Recording Form be submitted to AHIMS for all harmed sites.
6. The Proponent has avoided 111 Aboriginal sites within the Project area through a considered design of the Project components. Where sites or PAD areas are located within 20 m of the development footprint, these sites or PADs will be protected during construction of the Project through temporary fencing. The location of the fencing will be determined on the advice of a qualified archaeologist and a representative from the RAPs.
7. The location of all Aboriginal sites and PADs will be shown on all appropriate plans to ensure that they are not inadvertently harmed.
8. All land disturbing activities will remain within the development footprint. Any works proposed outside the development footprint would require further archaeological assessment.

9. Inductions for workers will include a cultural heritage awareness procedure to ensure they recognise Aboriginal artefacts and familiarisation with the unanticipated finds protocol provided as Appendix 4 within the ACHAR (OzArk 2025).

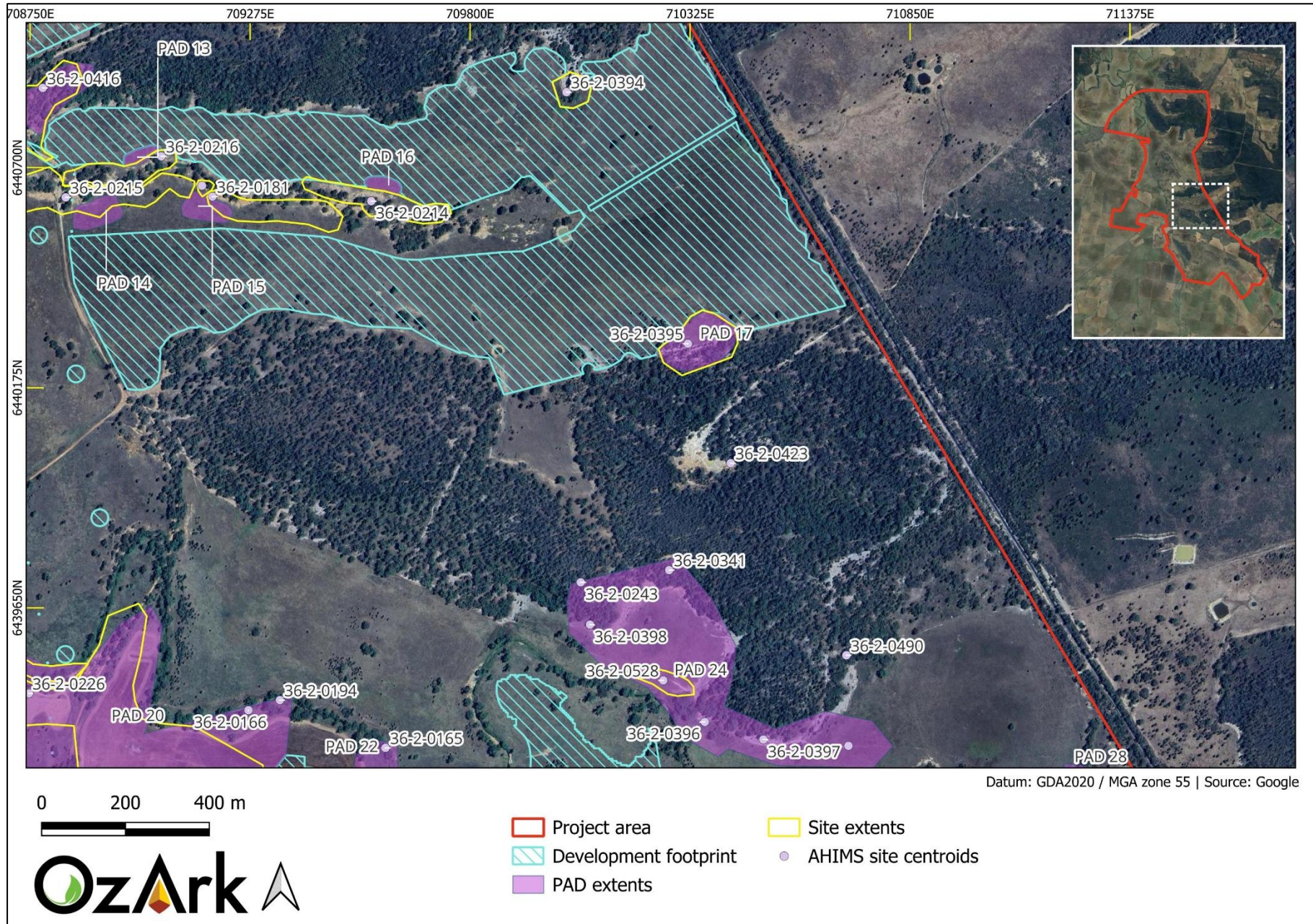
Detailed view of information presented in Figure 8-2 of the ACHAR (OzArk 2025)

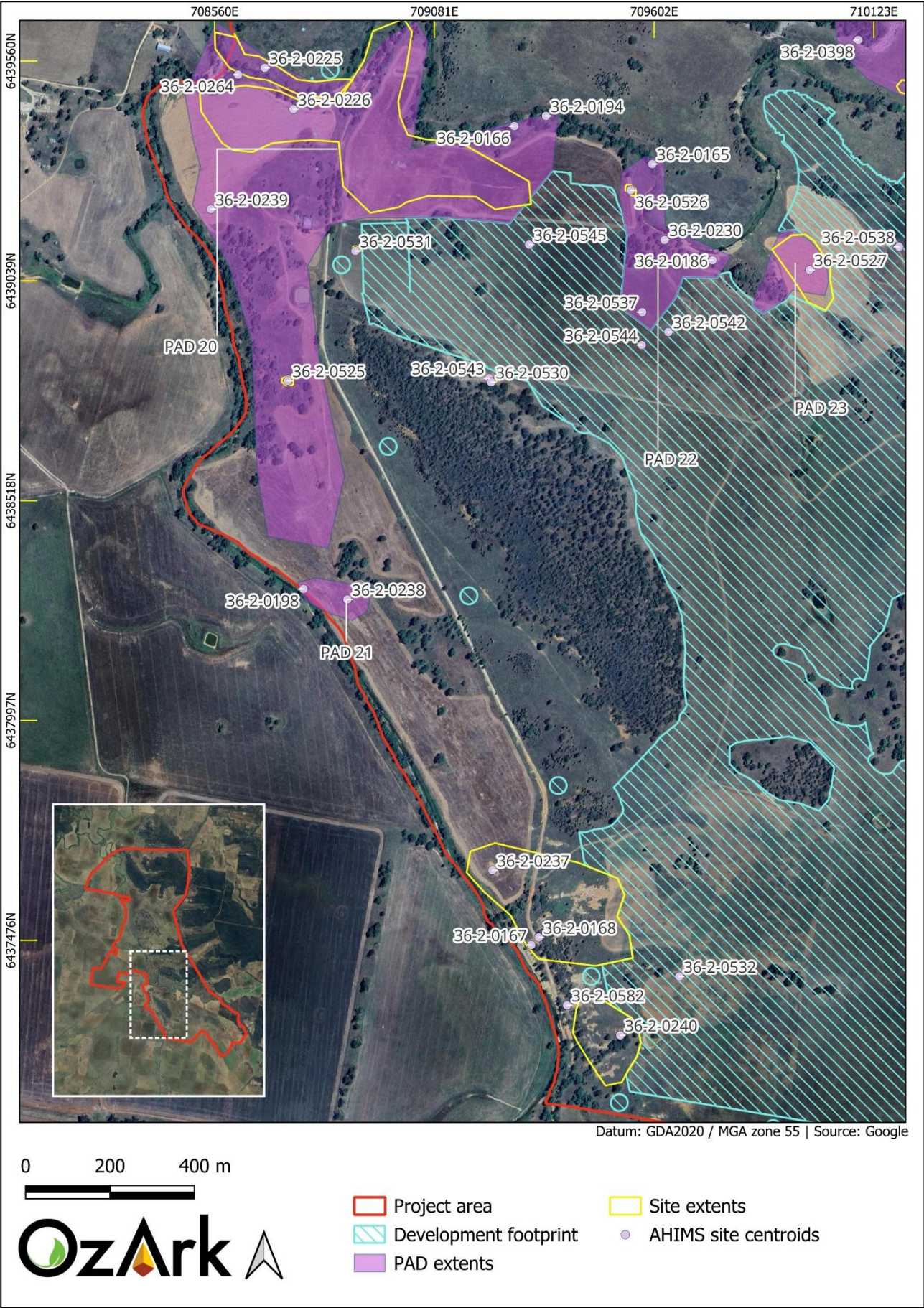


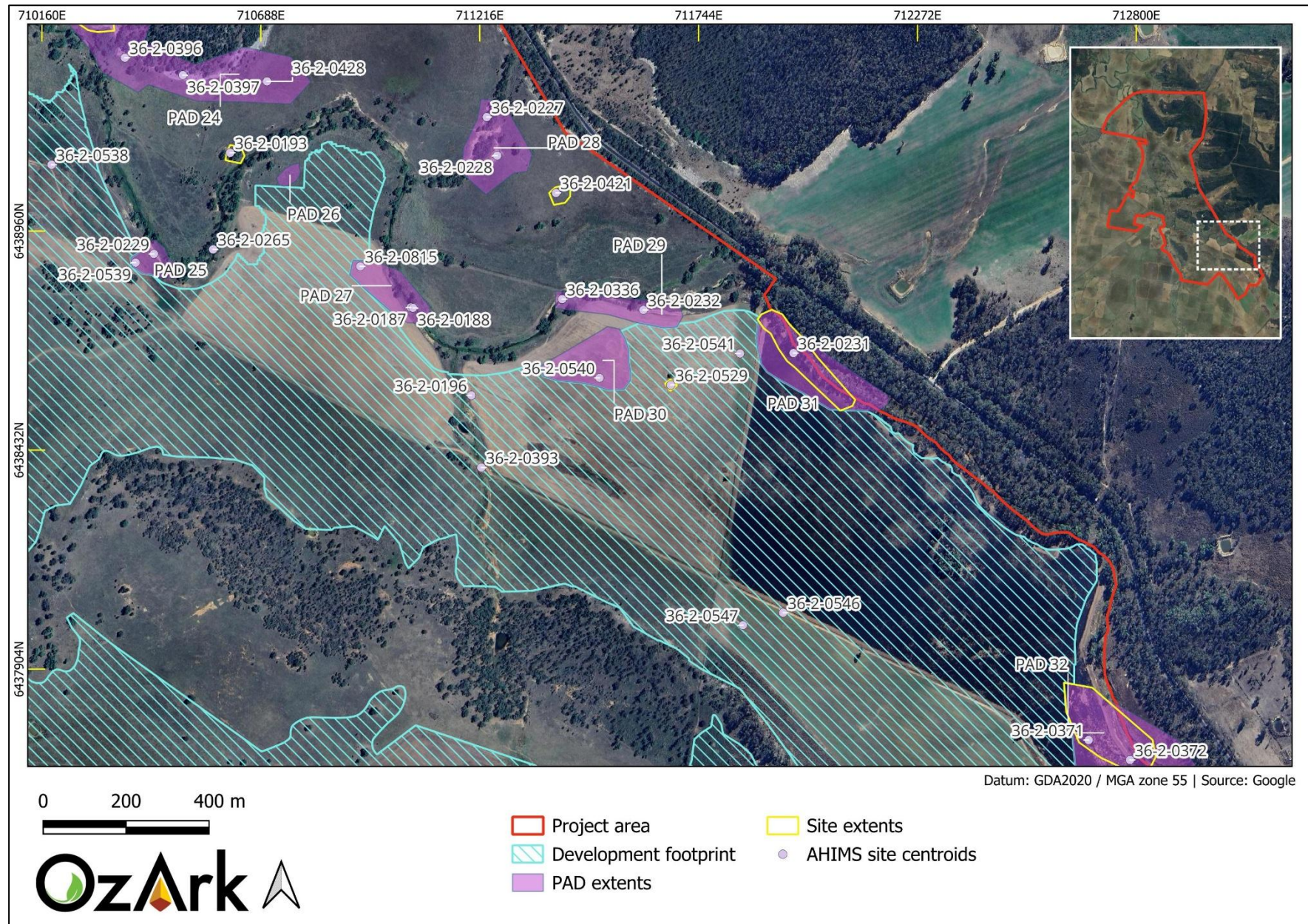


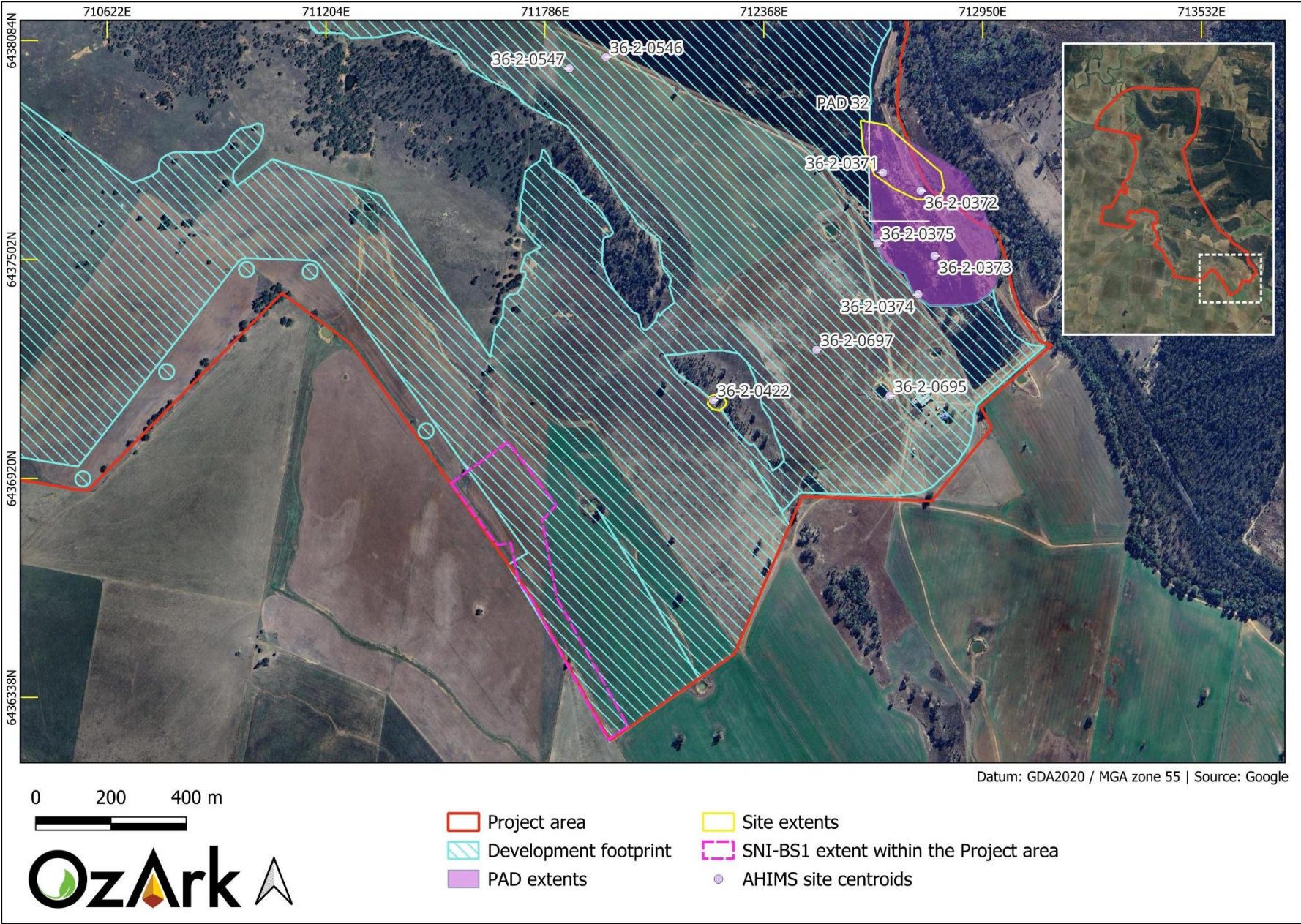
