Hi Kelly

I refer to the Response to Submissions (RTS) report for the Modification Application to the Spring Farm ARRT Facility (005\_0098 MOD 6). The RTS was referred to Camden Council, the EPA and ESS (formerly OEH) to confirm that the issues raised in their submissions have been addressed. Their responses are attached.

It is requested that you provide further information to address the outstanding issues in the EPA's letter (14 August 2019), as well as the Department's comments below, in either a revised RTS or in an addendum to the RTS.

The Department's comments:

- Modification details:** The inconsistency in the lot and DP details referred to in the Department's letter dated 26 March 2019 includes:
  - Land description in the Project Approval (as modified in MOD 2): Lot 35 DP 1098588, Lot 21 DP 112 5616, Lot 2 DP 1076817 and Lot 33 DP 1096463
  - RTS for MOD 6: Lot 35 DP 1098588.
- Noise:** Given the proximity to sensitive receivers, the NIA should include an assessment of the noise impacts between 6 am and 7 am from vehicles accessing the site. This should include noise from the weighbridge area.
- Industrial liquid waste:** There appears to be some discrepancy on the processing of industrial liquid waste at the facility. The RTS states that industrial liquid waste was assessed and approved as part of MOD 5. The Department's Assessment Report for MOD 5 refers to organic liquid waste and leachate but not industrial liquid waste, inferring that the processing of liquid industrial waste was not assessed. This is reflected in the Instrument of Modification.
