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As a resident of Mount Annan we are constantly subjected to the odours from the SITA site at Spring Farm. Any increase of activity on the site will lead to additional odours we have to endure.

There are better sites to do this type of work at further out of Sydney. With development going ahead all the way around the spring farm site increasing the amount of processing done on the site is against the public interest. The site will need to eventually be closed down and replaced with sporting fields.

Residents moving into the Spring Farm release area unless doing their own research are presented on all maps and documentation from the developers that playing fields are going to be covering the Spring Farm SITA Site.

This created a precedent in the community that the site is to be shut down, the development proposal goes against this community interest and expectations.

We are already exposed to potential dangers with the AGL Camden gas project using land on the SITA site.

The Mount Annan Botanical Gardens are located next door to the SITA site further processing of materials on the SITA site could potentially lead to environment damage to the endangered Cumberland woodlands preserved on this site, additional odours and noise impacts.

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
