



Streetscape - Avenue of Fig trees and layered understorey planting to screen fences and carparks creating a clear division of spatial quality for both workers and pedestrians on footpath while offering a distinctive streetscape.



Entry - Seasonal colour and feature blade wall with planting provide a sense of arrival to the site. Representational planting like ornamental sugar cane are used to provide a sense of the Coca-cola's image and identity.



Main building with native tree planting and layered understorey provides buildings with a green front while allowing landscape views from within.



Carpark planting character consists of Eucalyptus and mass plantings of native grass understorey in the median strips, providing shade and relief to the large surface carpark.

Avenue planting of Ficus hillii with understorey plantings of Ivy. The large Fig trees keep the landscape in scale with the buildings and understorey plantings of Ivy.



Fraxinus provides seasonal colour, Crinum spp gives form and foliage contrast to the understorey. Grevilleas and Star jasmine provide with foliage and flower colour interest.



Blending existing natives with new plantings of Eucalyptus to provide shade for carpark. Plantings of Paperbarks and Isolepis along the creek edge help restore the visual and environmental quality of the site.

Exposed Aggregate Finish for landscape paved areas at drivers amenities and dry creek areas



Typical planting and lay out design of wetland planting allowing for access in both dry and flood times around the creek edge. Gravel/rock and grasses on overland flow path enhance the dry creek character.

Aluminium bench seating provides durability and flexibility for seating on either side. It can also work as a table bench.
