


Landscape Design Statement. Vincentia, NSW, Stage 3, Specialised Retail Precinct.

The Shoalhaven Development Control Plan 2014, Chapter G3: Landscaping Design Guidelines has been reviewed and considered in the formulation of the Vincentia Lifestyle and Wellness Precinct. In addition, the 'Shoalhaven Species List for Vincentia' has been used in the formulation of the planting schedule.

The site is bounded to the west by Naval College Road and to the south by The Wool Road. The site is stage 3 of the Vincentia Marketplace area.

The landscape concept design focuses on the following landscape design principles:

- To re-establish, revegetate and enhance the interface landscapes at the edges of the stage 3 site.
- 2. To create a clear landscape character that allows clarity of wayfinding, safe and open sightlines for both pedestrians and vehicles, not unduly blocked by landscape, yet incorporating tall canopy trees where possible with lower understorey planting so that pedestrians and drivers can see under the tree canopies and over the low vegetation.
- 3. The planting palette comprises native plants so as to integrate with its context and the surrounding creek line vegetation zone and the vegetated area to the east.
- 4. Native screen vegetation is proposed along the west facing, blank wall of the proposed building near the roundabout corner of The Wool Road and Naval College Road to both diffuse the built form, screen the loading zone, as well as deter the use of the wall for graffiti.
- 5. Visual changes with tree species are implemented to delineate and mark the
- Trees are also employed for creation of landscape habitat corridors as well as to provide shade to car parking bays where possible.

The proposed vegetation is predominantly native, locally suitable, similar to the species proposed in stage 2 and at Vincentia Market Place so as to create consistent 'landscape design language and palette'. The 'Shoalhaven Species List for Vincentia' has been utilised to create this planting schedule.

Planting within the site boundary is proposed to be irrigated, mulched and maintained to establishment and ongoing maintenance following.
