
Section 75W of the *Environmental Planning & Assessment Act 1979*

SCHEDULE 1

Project Approval

The Car Park Remediation Project (06_0197), which was approved on 12 November 2009

SCHEDULE 2

1. Delete DECCW from the definitions.
2. Insert the following into the definitions after the definition of OCS:
OEH Office of Environment & Heritage
3. Replace all references to DECCW in the conditions of approval with OEH.
4. Change the definition of the Department to read Department of Planning & Infrastructure.
5. Change the definition of the Director-General to read Director-General of the Department (or delegate).
6. Change the definition of Minister to read Minister for Infrastructure and Planning
7. Replace Condition 2 in Schedule 2 with the following:
 - 2 The Proponent shall carry out the project generally in accordance with the:
 - (a) EA;
 - (b) site plans (see Appendix A);
 - (c) Submissions Report;
 - (d) Remedial Action Plan (RAP);
 - (e) Statement of Commitments (see Appendix B);
 - (f) Exemption Application and EPA Exemption Order (see Appendix C);
 - (g) Technology Assessment;
 - (h) Modification application (06_0028 Mod 2) with supporting documentation titled Supporting Documentation for a Request to Modify a Major Project Car Park Waste Encapsulation Remediation, Treatment of contaminated soils and concrete at the Directly-heated Thermal Desorption Plant other than those in the CPWE, prepared by Orica; and
 - (i) conditions of this approval.
8. Replace Condition 8 of Schedule 2 with the following:
 - 8 The Proponent shall only process the following material on site:
 - (a) contaminated materials obtained from the CPWE site; and
 - (b) up to 1,000 tonnes of low level HCB contaminated material obtained from Store E on the BIP site.

9. Add the following after Condition 48

Relocation Management Plan

- 49 Prior to relocating the contaminated material at Store E, the Proponent shall prepare a Relocation Management Plan to the satisfaction of both OEH and the Director-General. This plan must identify the measures that would be implemented to minimise the potential impacts of the relocation process, and be implemented to the satisfaction of both OEH and the Director-General during the relocation process.
