Peppertree Quarry (MP 06_0074) Road Transport Request

I refer to your request to dispatch quarry products by road in accordance with condition of consent A10 of Schedule 2 of the Peppertree Quarry development consent.

You advise that disruption to the rail network due to industrial action is causing supply issues for aggregates across Boral's Sydney network of asphalt and concrete batching plants. Consequently, you seek approval to dispatch up to 60 laden heavy vehicles per day from the quarry for an 8-week period.

To ensure the continued supply of these essential construction materials I approve the request in accordance with condition A10, subject to the following requirements:

- transportation hours set by condition A12 of the consent are met (i.e., 7 am to 7 pm);
- transportation by road must cease after eight weeks from the date of this letter;
- convoying of heavy vehicles is suitably minimised;
- the requirements of condition B44 of the consent are met; and
- impacts to the local and regional traffic network are suitably managed in conjunction with Boral's Marulan South Limestone Mine.
