The project approval for the Chemsal Chemical Storage and Treatment Facility granted by the Minister for Planning on 22 December 2006 (06_0095).

SCHEDULE 2

1. Delete the definitions for "DEC" and insert the following:

DECCW Department of Environment, Climate Change and Water

2. Delete all references to "DEC" and replace with "DECCW".

3. Delete condition 2(d) of Schedule 2 and replace with the following:

- (e) modification application 06_0095 Mod 2 and accompanying Environmental Assessment titled *Environmental Assessment Chemical Immobilisation and Solidification Process* dated 2 November 2009 and the revised site layout titled *Figure 2.1 Proposed Chemical Immobilisation and Solidification*, revision 3 dated 18 January 2010; and
- (f) conditions of this consent.

4. After condition 10 of schedule 3 insert:

10A. Prior to the treatment of any waste material, the Proponent must obtain an approval under the provisions of the *Protection of the Environment Operations (Waste) Regulation 2005* from DECCW.

5. Delete condition 12 of schedule 3 and replace with the following:

The Proponent shall prepare and implement a Construction Safety Study for the CIS process (06_0095 Mod 2) to the satisfaction of the Director-General. The plan shall be submitted to the Director-General prior to commencing construction of the CIS processing area and shall be prepared in accordance with the Department's

The Proponent shall implement the recommendations of the Construction Safety Study as appropriate, and shall comply with all reasonable requirements of the Director-General in respect if the implementation of any measures arising from the recommendations, within such time as the Director-General may require.
