**CAPACITY IN EDUCATION INFRASTRUCTURE TO SERVICE A PROPOSED  
71 LOT SUBDIVISION IN MANYANA DRIVE, MANYANA**

I refer to your letter dated 16 July 2007 seeking the NSW Department of Education and Training's comments regarding the proposed 71 lot subdivision at Manyana and its impact on existing education facilities.

Currently Manyana is serviced by Milton Public School. Milton Public School has recently had major capital works to upgrade and extend facilities on site with eight additional home bases and a newly completed communal hall. High school students from Manyana attend Ulladulla High School.

Based on historical and current demographic data Manyana has maintained its profile as a vacation destination with only 27 percent of homes occupied at the 2006 Census. The number of school aged children has remained small with a ratio of 8 per 100 dwellings for 5-14 years olds in 2006. Therefore it is anticipated that any new enrolments from the proposed development can be accommodated in existing local schools.
