**Shoalhaven Starches MP06_0228 Mod 28 Temporary Emergency Grain Storage Bunker
Condition 21 Acid Sulfate Management Plan**

To whom it may concern,

A copy of the requirements as specified in Schedule 3, Condition 21 of Shoalhaven Starches Development Consent MP06_0228 is shown below:

20. The Applicant shall prepare an Acid Sulfate Soil Management Plan for the development, as modified. The plan must be prepared in accordance with the Acid Sulfate Soils Manual (Acid Sulfate Soils Management Advisory Committee, 1998), and be submitted to the Secretary prior to the commencement of construction. The plan must include specific measures to manage Acid Sulphate Soils during construction of the grain intake pit and piling works described in MOD 16.

We have reviewed the requirements of the condition and provide the following comments:

- The temporary emergency grain bunker project does not involve any site excavation works that could potentially disturb any acid sulfate soils.

We are therefore seeking confirmation that an Acid Sulfate Management Plan will not be required for Shoalhaven Starches Development Consent MP06_0228, Schedule 3, Condition 21 for the Emergency Grain Bunker project.
