Subject: Queensland Hunter Gas Pipeline Project

We are completely opposed to the Queensland Hunter Gas Pipeline coming through our area for several reasons as follows;

- Safety
- Close proximity to open cut mining [constant blasting]
- Soil composition [shallow, stoney & underlaid rock]
- Major geological fault
- Water system [Glennies Creek Catchment]
- Biodiversity Corridor for flora & fauna
- major gully flooding

The Greenlands area targeted for the pipeline is a smaller acreage subdivision, whereas slightly to the west is open grazing country. The kilometer marking on the QHGP for our area [ie 733-734] is different to kilometer marking on the map your representatives have given us [ie 738-740] is this of any significant or due to detours increased kilometers to our area? An almost straight line can be drawn through open country between QHGP 728 [Tank Mountain – Cross Creek area] to 739.
