My family & I certainly oppose the QHCP proposal.

The map we were shown but (could not obtain a copy) "Portion 46" in our present seven year drought is the only water we could dig & water this farm & you propose to go across. This is not on when by crossing above the "Middlebrook Bridge" these water holes could be avoided. We cannot disturb the creek banks we have to dig 1 metre out so how can you dig the creek. Where do you get your authority?

"Part Portion 15" a 79 ac. block you want to cross (north to south). We will be building a house, a dam, plough & plant trees olive & grape vines as well as a windbreak. How far will the pipeline be under the ground & it is to go on the back fence line?

V We want group meetings not individual talks.

2/ Accus to "Local maps" showing the exact location of the pipeline on this property, not broad farm maps as shown in a recent book & sheets now available.

3/ Devaluation of land - Compensation does not help. "We own the land" & want the right to work & do with it as we wish. Not some "fly-by-nights" taking over & destroying our country & livelihood. In the name of progress millions are being made.

This is some of the most fertile country in N.S.W.

Find another route around or away from our small farms. Go east please! where the properties are much larger & not so many will be affected.

Hoping this submission does not fall on deaf ears.
