

# Greyhound Racing

Six races are set down to be decided at the Newmarket Raceway today. Last race meeting saw the 375m track record being broken by the local champ "Iceni Riot" owned and trained by the Gray kennel. The little black jet ran them off their feet breaking the previous mark by just 0.02. Iceni Riot was one of three winners for the Gray team at that race meeting, with sister Iceni Riddler also saluting the judge in first place.

Race 1 The Bob Dannatt Appreciation Maiden Sprint, has four greyhounds engaged by Bob, can one of them finally break the duck. Bob's greyhound Amber Danae has two placings to her name in recent weeks, that should be good enough to win this race. Second selection is Swag Present trained by Clayton Tregrove. He has also had a few placings and could be the greyhound to cause an upset and deny Bob that winner he's been looking for. Third pick is Spanish Bullion, who is also trained by Bob, ran a few placings before being back in the field in his last two starts.

Race 2 The Far West Rural Supplies Stake sees a small field of just five greyhounds contest the longer journey of the 525 metres. Cheque Money trained by Craig Thomas has come up with the red box and looks the winner of this race. In his first start on the local track for Craig, Cheque Money ran a handy third behind newly crowned track record holder Iceni Riot and with that look at the track it should be enough to take out this race.

Second selection is Iceni Hunter trained by Susan Gray. Iceni Hunter won over this journey a few starts back and will be right in the finish chasing home Cheque Money. Third

pick is Mootwingee for visiting SA trainer Clint Tregrove.

Race 3 The Happy Birthday Amy Searle Sprint a full field for the FFA greyhounds. The new track record holder Iceni Riot, trained by Susan Gray takes to the track to try and make it back to back wins in as many starts. Drawn in box three, she should leave them standing at the start of the race and continue on her winning way.

Second selection is Foxy Cruiser trained by Scott Slater. Foxy Cruiser chased home Iceni Riot last start and was never disgraced, she should finish in second placing. Any one of the other greyhounds could finish in the third position in this race, Adesanya trained by Tegan Gray won two starts ago and could be the one to fill the third position.

Race 4 The Broken Hill Community Credit Union Sprint is another small field of five for the grade 4 greyhounds. Last start winner All Out Mini trained by Kaylene Hatzl has come up with the red box and could make it back to back wins. All Out Mini led all the way last start and if she can produce the same performance should take out this event.

Flying Chopper trained by Jack Tregrove will be All Out Mini's main danger as she only beat Flying Chopper by a nose last start, he's racing in good form lately and will be finishing on strong at the end of the race. Third selection is Compton Peggy for visiting trainer Harrison Tregrove.

Race 5 The Volunteers Appreciation Sprint sees a nice field for the first of two races for the grade 5 greyhounds. Last start winner Iceni Riddler trained by Susan Gray has drawn

awkwardly in the yellow box, but if she can jump and lead like her last start then she could be the winner of this event.

All Ahead Brin trained by Lorraine Robertson is the pick to finish in second placing, he will be the big danger for Iceni Riddler as finishes his races off very strong and will be the one to watch in the run home to the judge. Third selection is War Bird trained by Troy Roberts. War Bird is down in grade and might be able to figure in the placings in this race as she has been racing in much tougher company than this race.

Race 6 The GT Loader Appreciation Sprint, the last race of the day and brings together a very even field. Iceni Boudica trained by Susan Gray is the pick to take this event out. If she can race like she did last start she should be the winner of this race. Second will be kennel mate to Iceni Boudica, Pearcedale Flyer trained by Tegan Gray. He was a last start winner on the track but if Iceni Boudica puts a foot wrong he will run over the top of her.

Third selection is Erratic Heist trained by Troy Roberts. Erratic Heist won two starts ago then followed that a second placing behind Pearcedale Flyer and should run into third placing today.

October is confirmed to see the running of the Broken Hill Cup which has \$10,000 awarded to the winner of the event. This will be run over two weeks with heats and finals which will be televised live on Sky racing, the first of its kind for Greyhound racing in Broken Hill. Gates open today at 1pm and the bunny gets under way with the first race at 1.40pm. Full bar and canteen facilities available. TAB in operation.

## RASP MINE UPDATE

### RASP MINE MODIFICATION 6

Plans are progressing for tailing storage optimisation at the Rasp Mine. In order to provide a long term tailing storage solution, Broken Hill Operations will soon be seeking to modify its current Ministerial approval for the Rasp Mine.

### WHAT IS BEING PROPOSED?

The project primarily involves using the Kintore Pit to store tailing and relocating the current mine entry in the Kintore Pit and replacing it with a box-cut entry on the surface. It also involves using an existing tailing facility to harvest naturally dried tailing for placement into Kintore pit and utilising suitable (low lead) waste rock for rehabilitation capping. All the proposed changes will be undertaken within the existing mine site and are expected to take up to 12 months to complete.

### WHAT STUDIES ARE BEING UNDERTAKEN?

To progress plans for the proposed modification, BHOP is undertaking a range of detailed safety and environmental studies to ensure that any risks or impacts of the project can be managed and effectively mitigated. The studies undertaken include noise and vibration, air quality, geotechnical analysis, community health and water quality.

### APPROVAL PROCESS

The modification application and Modification Report will be assessed by the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE). BHOP anticipates the modification application will be lodged with DPIE in September 2021. DPIE will place the application on public exhibition so the community can comment on the project.
