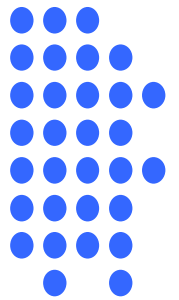

Dear Tim,

Re: Construction of a Pipeline across a Shire Road

I refer to your letter dated 6 November 2007 seeking Council's requirements in relation to a gas pipeline crossing Shire Roads. Please accept my apology for the delay in replying.

Council's requirements for gas pipelines within the road reserve are as follows

- a) The depth to the top of the pipeline must be a minimum for 1.5m below the existing table drain;
- b) Where it is intended that the pipeline will cross a sealed road or watercourse the pipeline shall be under bored and cross at as close to 90 degrees as possible;
- c) Where it is intended that the pipeline will be laid along a road it must be parallel to the current road centreline (+500mm) and as close as possible to the property boundary or current edge of heavy vegetation line;
- d) Indicator wire must be placed above the pipeline to the satisfaction of the Director Engineering Services;
- e) No work is to be conducted on site without a Council representative present to verify the pipeline installation;
- f) The contractor is to prepare a Project Plan (authorised by a suitably qualified engineer) addressing Quality, Environmental and Safety (including Traffic) issues, and this plan is to be approved by the Director Engineering Services before commencement of works (see below);
- g) A works-as-executed plan must be prepared by a registered surveyor or qualified engineer showing the horizontal and vertical location of the pipeline,
- h) The contractor is to meet Council's daily supervision costs prior to work commencing, any savings will be refunded by Council;
- i) The installation of the pipeline is not to inhibit future road works, including compaction with vibrating rollers or require Council to seek any special permission to work within its road reserve in the vicinity of the pipeline.

 - Owner
 - Principle Contractor and Subcontractors
 - Principle Consultant and Subconsultants

4. Key Contacts List and Responsibility List
5. Key Milestones for the Project
6. A Risk Assessment for the Project
7. Traffic Control Plan (in accordance with the RTA's Traffic Control at Worksites)
8. Waste Management Plan
 - Identifies the type and quantity of the major waste streams that will be generated by the project
 - How and where the waste is to be reused, recycled, stockpiled or disposed
 - How and who will transport the waste between generation storage and point of reuse, recycling, stockpiling or disposal.
 - Responsible Contact
9. Soil Water Management Plan
 - Location of the site compounds
 - Control structures
 - Maintenance of Control Structures
 - Responsible Contact

The Project Plan to be an integrated document with all pages sequentially numbered and revisions register kept up to date.

RE: Gas Pipeline – Road Crossings

I refer to your letter dated 3 April 2008 requesting confirmation from Council in regards to the gas pipeline crossing Shire Roads.

In response to your queries,

1. Council has inspected the location of the proposed road crossings and has no issues with these locations providing that you meet the requirements as previously stated in the letter of 16 January 2008.
2. The requirements as stated in the letter of 16 January 2008 will still be applicable to glass fibre reinforced pipe. This is to ensure any future road works will not impede on the gas line.
3. The requirements as stated in the letter of 16 January 2008 will still be applicable to the crossing under the unformed section of road. Again this is to ensure any future road works will not impede on the gas line.
