MAJOR PROJECT APPLICATION 07_0070 WOLLONGONG PRIVATE HOSPITAL

I refer to your correspondence dated 28 April 2010 seeking comment on the above mentioned major project. Transport NSW appreciates the opportunity to provide input to the environmental assessment of this application.

As you are aware, Transport NSW has previously provided advice to the Department of Planning in regard to this proposal. It is noted that a transport and traffic assessment report will accompany the environmental assessment. Consistent with previous advice, Transport NSW requests that the transport report address the following issues:

- Achievement of mode shift target for Wollongong CBD in accordance with the State Plan;
- Achievement of State Plan target for walking and cycling. In this regard, the proposal should facilitate the implementation of actions in the 2010 NSW Bike Plan and should include measures for the provision of cycle amenities;
- The application of a minimalist approach to car parking which includes both on and off street locations and has regard to the accessibility of the site to public transport together with walking and cycling; and
- The preparation of a work place travel plan to ensure that a maximum number of employees and visitors to the site arrive by public transport together with walking and cycling.

Transport NSW is currently preparing the Illawarra Regional Transport Strategy and this proposal provides the opportunity to contribute to the achievement of the Strategy's objective of integrating land use and transport in the Illawarra.
