Please refrain from approving any drilling until the EPA water study is completed. Also here in Texas the air tests are showing that the setback has an inverse relationship with pollution fallout. 300 feet are bypassed and 600 feet folks has tested positive for BTEX chemicals. Today an environmental tester said that 1,500-3,000 ft setback shows for example benzene has higher levels than closer to the site. Do not devalue property and people's lives by drilling-find sustainables to be the real longterm solution. The Cornell study by Professor Howarth shows that natural gas may be as dirty as coal. I tried to send a picture of the YWCA at UT Arlington University which is within 300 ft of a drill site containing 22 wells behind that fence. A resident within 600 ft tested positive for BTEX.
