The proposed planting schedule generally complies with the species lists in the HMS. A few minor variations are discussed below:

Minor Variations:

Austrodanthonia linkii* var. *fulva is the same species as *Danthonia linkii* var. *fulva* which has been subject to a recent botanical name change. Therefore this species complies with the HMS requirements.

Dianella caerulea* var. *caerulea is listed in Appendix C, while both Appendices C and F contain *Dianella caerulea* var. *cinerascens*. It is considered preferable to plant

Dianella caerulea var. *caerulea* as this is the type recorded by Bell as naturally occurring on the site. However either variety would be suitable for landscaping works.

The HMS has always been recognised as not being a static document – invariably there will need to be changes made to the document over time to ensure that it remains current and relevant to the site. Additions to the species list for the HEZ may occur over time as new records come to hand, and the need to update the HMS in this manner has always been recognised. The HMS is currently being revised with some of the plant species not listed in the HMS and used in the landscape plan being considered for inclusion.

It is noted that ***Baumea articulata***, ***Carex appressa*** and ***Viola hederacea*** are included in Appendix C of the HMS that contains flora species identified in the study by Bell (2004), which lists all the species that have been recorded within the HEZ Study Area. It is therefore considered that, while not listed in Appendix F, these species are therefore considered appropriate for planting.
