Thanks for your mail & we appreciate & acknowledge concerns of WWCC.

As a project proponent, we would like to inform you that the process optimization is basically replacing few existing equipments and machineries with improved design & performance for the same application. All the replacement and installations will be done in existing acoustically protected building, hence chances of exceeding noise limits is unlikely.

Moreover, our management is keen complying with all the conditions given to us. As a part of our commitment, we are monitoring in-house noise at work place thrice in a year as a part of ROBE Health & Safety Program & once in a year by third party to ensure noise levels are well within the limits.

As suggested by City Council, ROBE will undertake compliance monitoring at the commencement of operations with Noise data logger & will submit to your good office. In case there is an unacceptable increase in noise emissions (which is extremely unlikely), ROBE will ensure to take remedial measures of covering with Noise abatement Systems like installation of acoustic Pads etc.

Also, ROBE will pay development contributions/ charges in accordance with City Council's Contribution Plans if applicable.
