**Ardmore Park Quarry (07\_0155 – PA-1)  
Acoustic Monitoring Report Sept 2020**

I refer to the Monitoring Report required under Schedule 3, condition 6 of the approval submitted by CEAL Limited (t/a Multiquip) to the Department in relation to Project 07\_0155 – PA-1 on 8 September 2020.

The Department is satisfied that the report meets relevant noise monitoring reporting requirements, and also notes that some readings occurred during a temperature inversion.

You are reminded that under Mod 3, the Noise Impact Assessment Criteria are to apply during F-Class temperature inversions and 2 metres/second draining winds during the 5am – 7am morning shoulder, and 3 metres/second wind during the day. In order to maintain compliance in these circumstances, temporary deferral or avoidance of certain quarry activities may be necessary.
