Please find following Council's submission on the Environmental Assessment for the modification:

- Risk assessment fails to identify bushfire impacts
- Typographical error on page 6 Part B, Residue management
- Emergency overflow stockpile areas for residues should be indentified and approved now. Some of the options proposed will take an extended time to implement, eg export to Korea.
- There appears only limited space near the chip screen on the western side of the development for residue overflow.
- Suggest an area on the Southern side of the site may be useful for residue overflows. This area is already in use for this purpose.
- It is noted that the disposal of the septic tank effluent requires both approval from Bombala Council and the Concurrence of the Office of water. Such approvals are likely to contain conditions pertaining to the handling of the waste and fees payable.

Please feel free to contact me if you require any further information on this matter. I will forward under separate cover details of a proposed residue handling development on the allotment immediately to the West.
