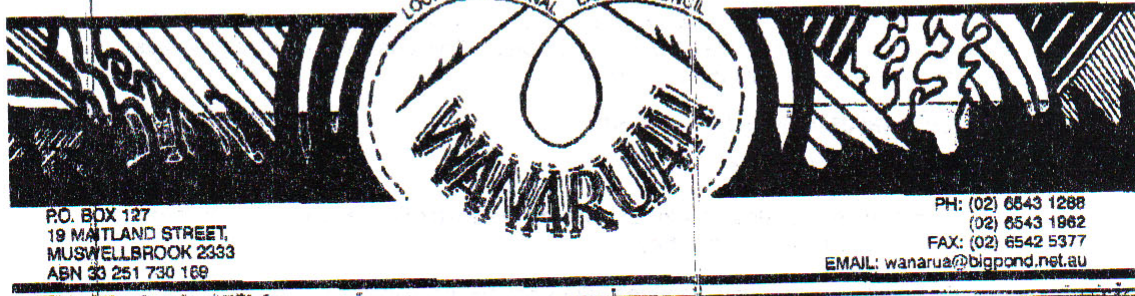

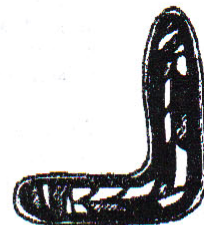

**RE: REVIEW OF MACQUARIE GENERATION PROPOSED GAS PIPELINE
NORTH-SOUTH ROUTE - ABORIGINAL ARCHAEOLOGICAL
ASSESSMENT - DRAFT REPORT**

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the draft report and management recommendations. We apologise for not responding sooner however we would like to make the following cultural considerations.

Generally, the Wanaruah LALC is in agreement with the findings of the report, the survey methodology used during the survey was acceptable and the coverage appeared to be sufficient. Stephen Boney represented the Land Council on the survey on 5 August 2008.

From a cultural point of view, the significance of the survey area as a whole is known to be high. Especially since it is recorded (NPWS site card 37-6-0056) that a Bora ground



is known to be present within close vicinity of Bulga¹. Aboriginal people including neighbouring tribes (possibly in large numbers at time) would have passed through the area on their travels to and from the Bora ground, camping and utilizing the natural resources that would have been present and keeping outside an 'eye and sound' buffer zone when the Bora ground was being used. A document in the Percy Haslam Collection² at the University of Newcastle describes the last combined Bora ceremony on the family property of A.N. Eather was held in 1852. An extract from this publication appeared in the December 1993 issue of the Singleton Times Newsletter, the journal of the Singleton Historical Society and stated that "This Bora ceremony was held in the year 1852, and on reliable authority of residents of the locality was attended by between 500 and 600 aborigines (sic) from various tribes from as far as Mudgee and Goulburn". Tribal groups from the south coast including the Dharrug and Darkinjung people are known to have travelled to the area through the Wollombi Brook catchment. There have been no combined analyses of all sites found to date within at least 10km of the Bora ground and their relationship to it. It would be of cultural and scientific significance if all the sites recorded in the region to date could be combined to tell the full story of the Bora ground in the future.

It was mentioned in your report that Kurrajong trees were noted at Brays Hill and Liddell. Kurrajong trees are known to have significance to the Aboriginal people in that roots contain water and they bear lots of seed even during drought periods. Many of these seeds were transported by the people to other areas where they were planted along travel routes and are seen today in some of the most unexpected locations. To other Aboriginal people, the Kurrajong tree holds spiritual/educational significance, for example in D'harawal (inland Illawarra region) tribal stories they help teach children to obey their parents (PHA NSW Heritage Register, 2001).
