Thanks for the call.

I'm writing to confirm our discussion, being that Council requests that the importation of ENM requires approval prior to delivery at the site, however that the importation of VENM may continue as previously approved - i.e. approval is not required before VENM is imported to the site, but the Applicant is required to retain adequate supporting documentation to demonstrate that the fill is VENM in accordance with Condition 18C of MP 08 0066, which reads:

18C. The importation of fill must meet the criteria of 'Virgin Excavated Natural Material' (VENM) as defined in EPA Environmental Guidelines – Assessment Classification and Management of Liquid and Non-Liquid Waste 1999. The proponent is required to keep supporting documentation (receipts / dockets) of VENM imported to site."

Hi Nici,

Further to our discussion on this matter, I confirm your previous advice to the DoP in relation to appropriate conditions to be applied to the Modification.

To clarify the matter and conditions that should be imposed, I have taken the liberty of amending those conditions for ease of reading. The intent of each recommended condition remains the same, however the wording is amended slightly for readability and updated (current) guideline references.

In this regard, please advise the DoP of Council's preference to have the following conditions imposed:

- Any soils / materials imported onto the site shall meet applicable contamination threshold limits for the proposed land use, as contained within the Department of Environment and Conversation publication *Contaminated Sites: Guidelines for the NSW Site Auditor Scheme* (2<sup>nd</sup> edition) 2006.
- Any soils / materials imported onto the site must meet the definition of Virgin Excavated Natural Material (VENM) as contained in the Department of Environment, Climate Change and Water publication *Waste Classification Guidelines Part 1: Classifying Waste (December 2009)*; or Excavated Natural Material (ENM) as per the Excavated Natural Material Exemption 2012, made under the *Protection of the Environment Operations (Waste) Regulation 2005 General Exemption Under Part 6, Clause 51 and 51A.*
- Prior to the importation of any soils / materials to the site, documentation to clearly satisfy the requirements of VENM / ENM shall be submitted to Fairfield City Council for approval.
- Any supporting documentation (such as records / receipts / dockets / log book entries) relating to the importation of VENM / ENM to the site shall be maintained at all times and made available to Council's Officers upon request.
- Any soils / materials imported onto the site shall be compacted in accordance with the Council's specifications.

The Resource Recovery Characterisation report, number RR-01, document number S0001265, dated 23 January 2014, prepared by DLA Environmental, specifies that the selected fill to be used will be from 467 Great Western Highway, Eastern Creek. The select fill to be used is classified as Excavated Natural Material (ENM).

Council's Environmental Management Standards Branch have raised no objection to the proposal pursuant to the following being undertaken;

- 1. The use of ENM in this instance is approved in accordance with the submitted:
- Earthwork Specification Filling, Cutting and Testing Report, dated 6 May 2013, report number: PSM1541-003S Rev 2 and
- The Resource Recovery Characterisation Report, number RR-01, Document number S0001265, dated 23 January 2014, prepared by DLA Environmental.
- 2. Proposed soils to be imported to the site shall meet applicable threshold limits for the proposed land use as contained within the Department of Environment and Conversation Guidelines for the NSW Site Auditor Scheme 2006.
- 3. The importation of fill must meet the criteria of 'Virgin Excavated Natural Material' as defined in EPA Environmental Guidelines Assessment Classification and Management of Liquid and Non- Liquid Waste 1999, or 'Excavated Natural Material' as per the Excavated natural material exemption 2012, made under the Protection of the Environment Operations (Waste) Regulation 2005 General Exemption Under Part 6, Clause 51 and 51A.
- 4. The compaction of fill shall be in accordance with the council's specifications.
- 5. The proponent is required to keep supporting documentation (receipts/ dockets) of VENM/ ENM imported to site.
- 6. The proponent must submit to Council test results, certificates and other relevant documentation to satisfy the requirements of VENM/ ENM proposed prior to being imported.
