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Regent Honeyeater

1. Within 6 months of the date of this approval, the Proponent shall calculate:
 - (a) the ~~potential impacts of generated by the impact of~~ the project on the Regent Honeyeater ~~in biodiversity (species) credits~~; and
 - (b) the ~~species~~ credits that would be generated for the Regent Honeyeater ~~under from implementation of~~ the offset strategy described in condition 27 above, in accordance with ~~the relevant calculators under~~ the *NSW Biodiversity Offset Policy for Major Projects*, and to the satisfaction of OEH.

2. If the calculations carried out in condition x above identify a shortfall of ~~species~~ credits to offset the impacts of the project, then within ~~18-24~~ months of the ~~completion of the calculations~~date of this approval, the Proponent shall ~~retire-satisfy the outstanding offset requirements the outstanding credits~~ to the satisfaction of OEH. This can be achieved by one or more of the following:

~~The retirement of these credits must be carried out in accordance with the NSW Biodiversity Offsets Policy for Major Projects and can be achieved by:~~
 - (a) acquiring or retiring credits under the Biobanking Scheme in the TSC Act;
 - (b) making payments into an offset fund that has been developed by the NSW Government; or
 - (c) providing supplementary measures.
