BASS POINT QUARRY PROJECT – MODIFICATION 2 (RESPONSE TO SUBMISSIONS)

Dear Melissa

Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) refers to your email dated 30 August 2018 regarding the above application and the applicants *Response to Submissions* (RTS) provided to RMS for comment.

RMS notes that:

- Its previous comments on the modification application (dated 2 March 2018) did not object to the proposed modification on that basis that it would not have a significant impact on the state road network (i.e. Shellharbour Road and the Princes Highway). Other roads on which transport of product associated with the use will occur, to gain access to Shellharbour Road, are local roads managed by Shellharbour City Council; and
- The RTS proposes no changes to the application in terms of the currently approved transport route and the approved maximum number of trucks on any day (i.e. 500).

Having regard for the above RMS, similar to its previous advice, does not believe the modification will have a significant impact on the state road network. On this basis RMS does not object to the modification application.
