# 1. Exploration Summary

## 1.1 Exploration

In 2023, surface exploration included drilling<sup>1</sup> of 7 partly-cored boreholes at Ulan Underground, 15 boreholes (8 partly-cored and 7 open) at Ulan West, 40 boreholes (16 partly-cored and 24 open hole) at Bungaba (EL8687/9363) and 3 partly-cored boreholes within EL9419 (**Table 1-1**) for mine design characterisation, geotechnical and coal quality purposes.

Of the 11433m drilled, 5097m was open hole drilling and 6336m was core drilling. Cored holes were chipped down to approximately 20m above the Ulan Seam, and then cored to total depth. The core is logged in the field and stored in the Ulan core shed. Exploration holes were geophysically logged, surveyed by site surveyors and then sealed and rehabilitated consistent with the requirements of the *Exploration Code of Practice: Rehabilitation*<sup>2</sup>. Coal quality testing results are positive to mining and the geological model was updated. No prospecting operations were undertaken in environmentally sensitive areas of state significance or exempted areas as defined by the *Mining Act 1992*.

The proposed 2024 exploration program is outlined in **Figure 1-1**; this program is subject to change based on operational requirements. There are 92 boreholes (25 UWW, 32 Cliffdale, 19 ULW & 16 UUG) planned to be drilled within the next Reporting Period. These boreholes will be drilled to characterise areas of geological and geotechnical concern and to monitor ground water.

Figure 1-1 - 2024 Proposed Exploration Areas

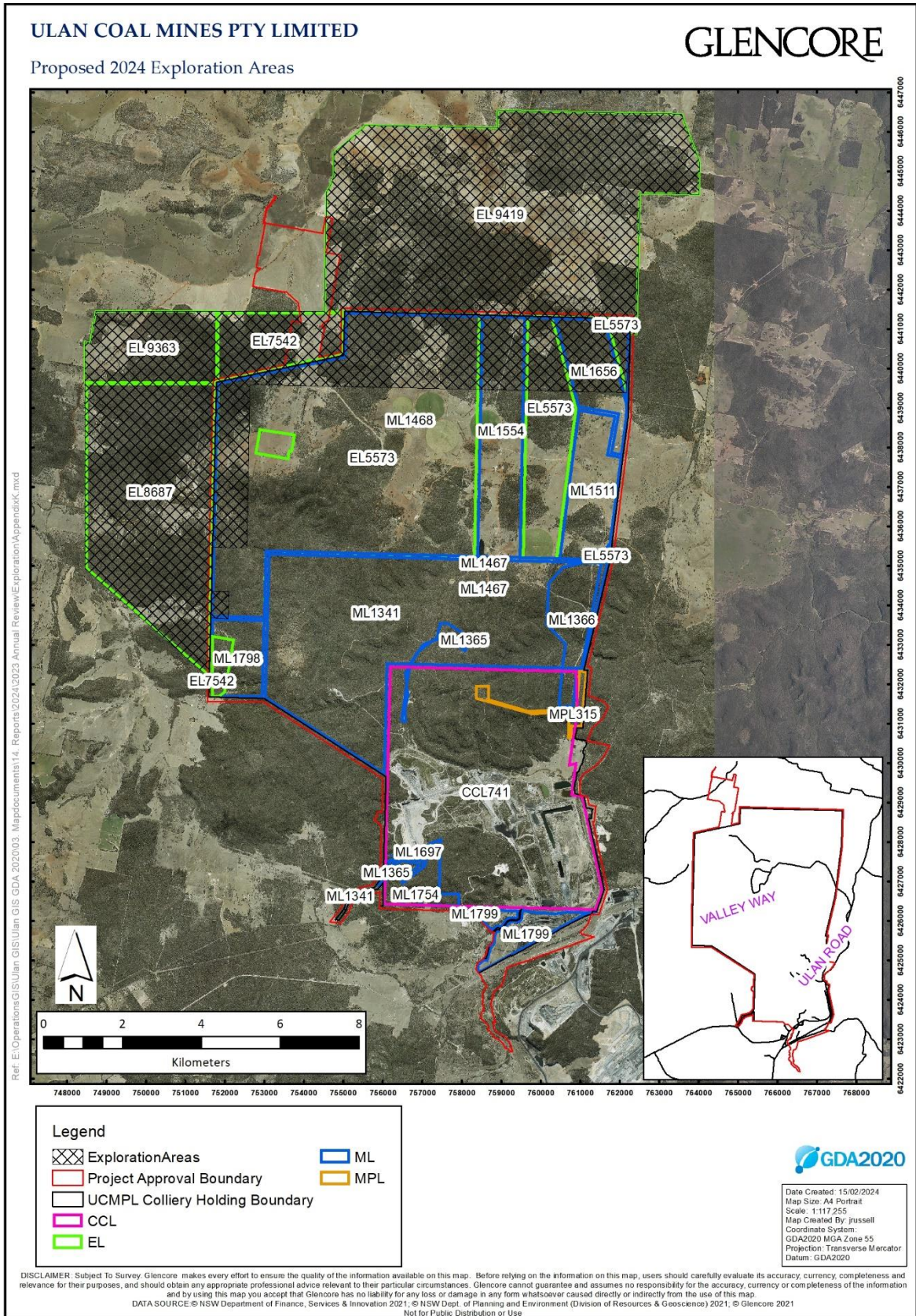


Figure 1-2 - Exploration Notice & Community Information (Mudgee Guardian 16/12/2022)

**Notice of Upcoming Exploration Activities**  
Bowdens Silver would like to notify community members of new mineral exploration programs planned within its Exploration Licences as part of ongoing exploration and Project Optimisation work for the Bowdens Silver Project.  
Drilling activities are planned to continue at the Bowdens Silver Project near Lue, with a focus to sterilise a number of areas that are required for construction of infrastructure as part of the mine development. ### HEROIC ARMY NURSE HONOURED

Recently, I visited the newly unveiled statue of Lieutenant Colonel Vivian Bullwinkel AO MBE at the Australian War Memorial.

This remarkable woman is a hero and deserving of each of the many accolades she received during her life. She is the first individual woman or nurse to be honoured by a statue in the grounds of the Australian War Memorial.

After completing high school and nursing training in Broken Hill, Lt. Col. Bullwinkel served in the Australian Army Nursing Service and was the only survivor of a massacre which occurred in 1942 on Banka Island off the coast of Indonesia. She then spent more than three years as a Prisoner of War.

After all of this she spent the rest of her life devoted to nursing, to honouring the memory of her fellow nurses who lost their lives, and to service. Hers is an incredible story of courage and resilience, which I hope all who visit her memorial will take the opportunity to reflect on.

### CONNECTIONS WITH THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA

One of my roles as Chief Whip for the Nationals is to provide briefings to delegations coming to Canberra through the Australian Political Exchange Council.

Last week I spoke to the 8th Delegation

from the Republic of Korea, including representatives from both the Democratic Party of Korea (DPK) which has been the ruling party over the last decade under different names and its opposition, the People Power Party (PPP).

They were very interested in the sheer size of the Parkes electorate, which is roughly 4 times the size of Korea, and how Australia balances its economic growth across both urban and regional areas, which is a challenge for both countries.

advancements in SMA research and treatment. New treatments are resulting in improved quality of life, especially for the next generation affected by SMA.

### RECOGNISING OUR LOCAL VETERANS

On Friday my wife Robyn and I attended events in Coolah to commemorate Veterans Day. On this day we paused to honour the 60,000 Australian troops who served in Vietnam; and remember the 523 who died, and the nearly 3,000 wounded. Each represented the values of our original ANZACs. We are proud of their service; and how they contributed to the safety of our country and our region. We also thanked the 63,740 Australians drafted for national service, our "Nashos", who so ably enhanced our war effort. The 18th of August falls on Vietnam Veterans' Day which marks the Battle of Long Tan in 1966. This was one of the heaviest Australian engagements of the war, when 108 soldiers of held off an enemy 2,000 strong; wounding 25 and taking the lives of 18 Australians including Paul Large of Coolah, who was just 21 years old.
